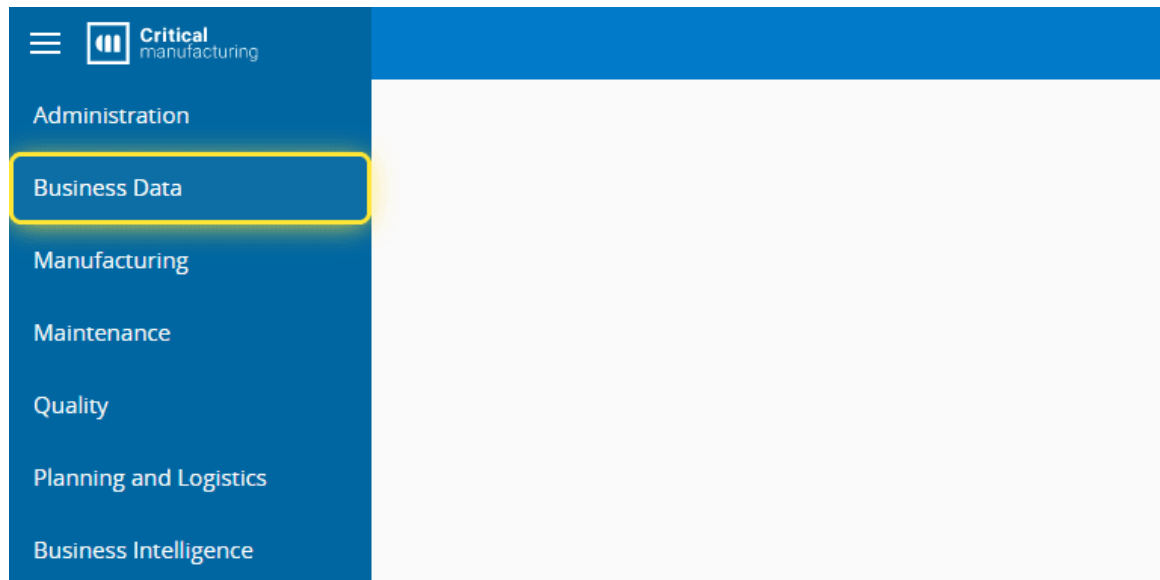

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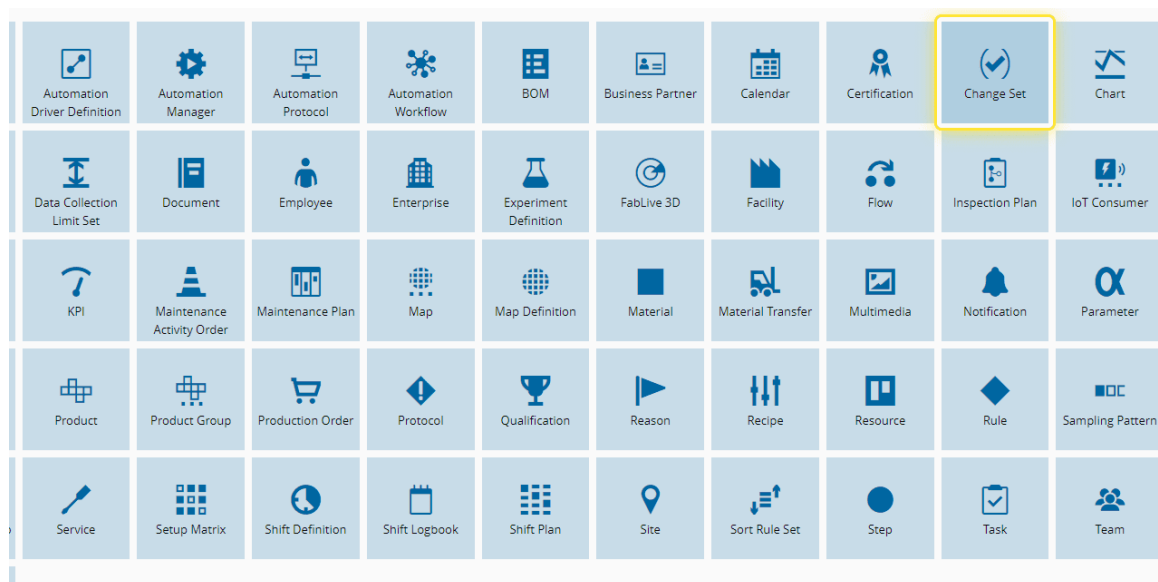
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How to: Manage Items in a Change Set

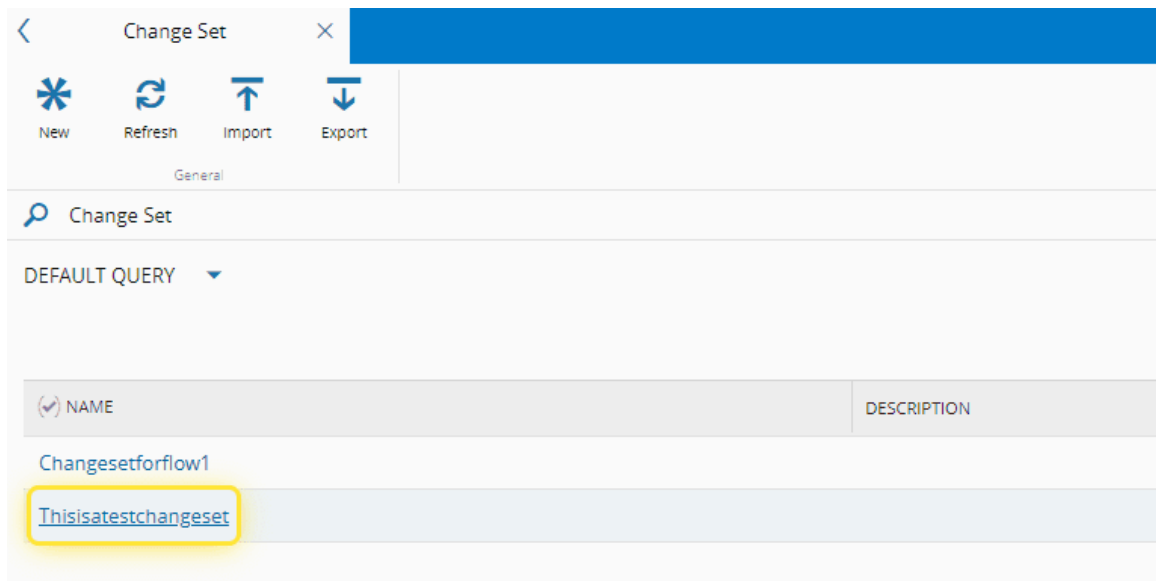
1. Go to the Business Data menu.



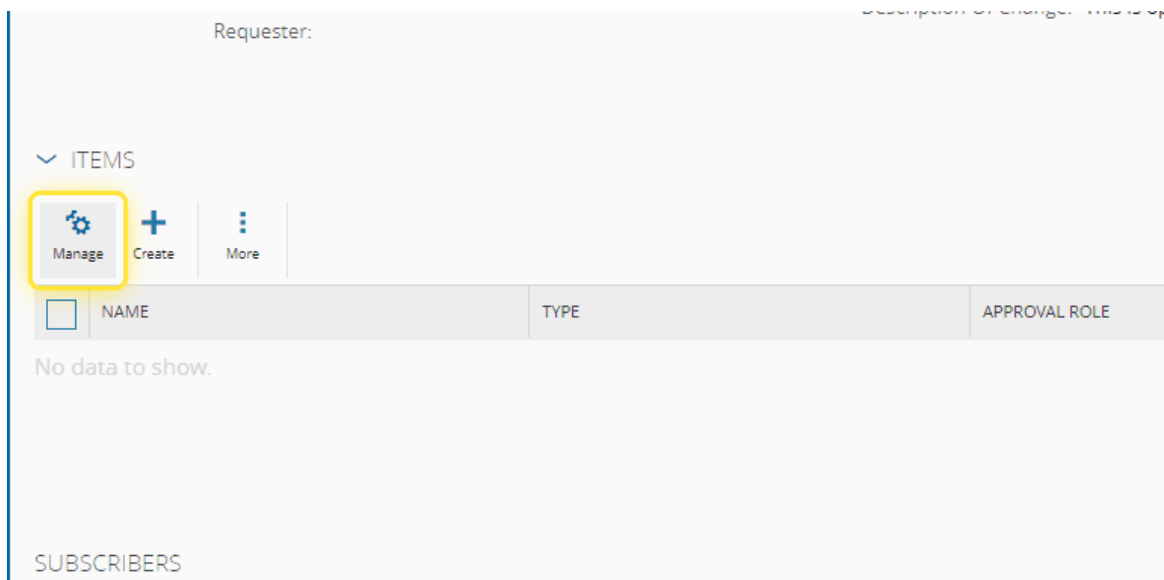
2. Select the Change Set entity.



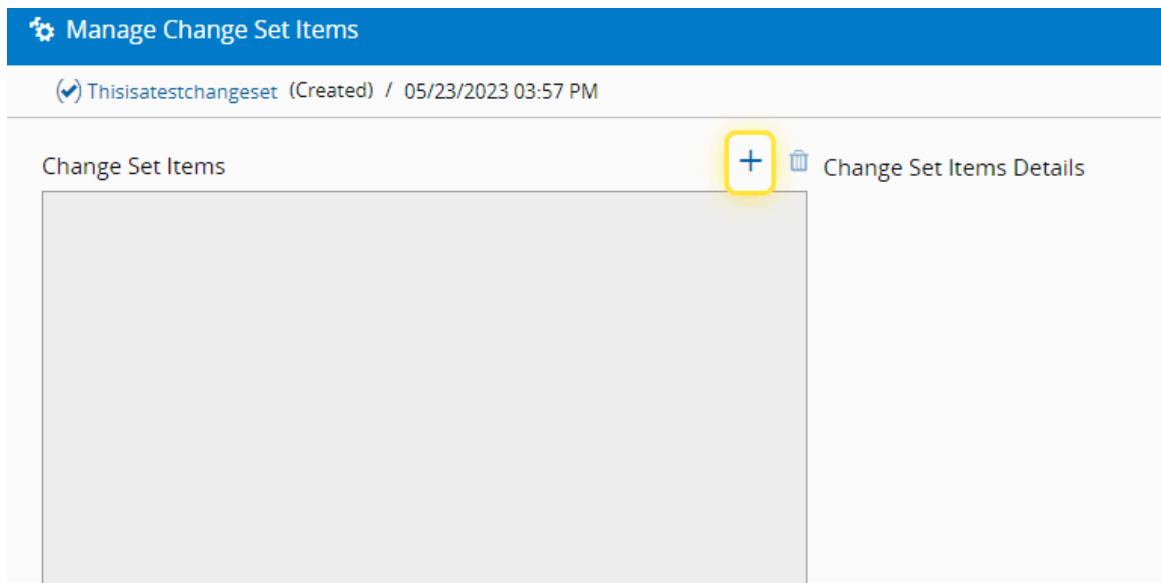
3. Select a Change Set .



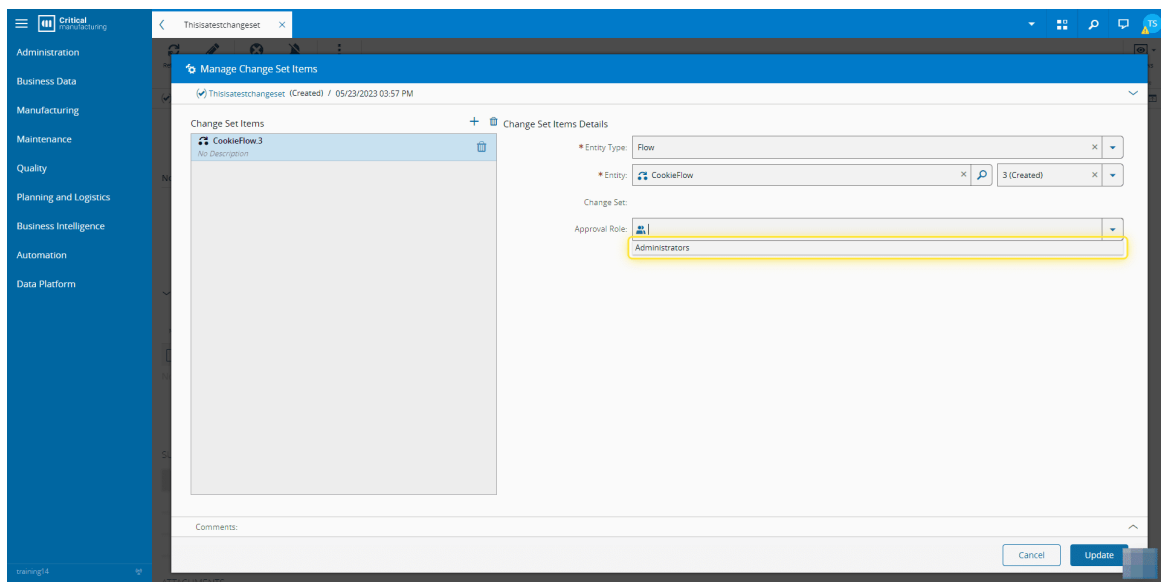
4. Under the Items tab, select Manage.
