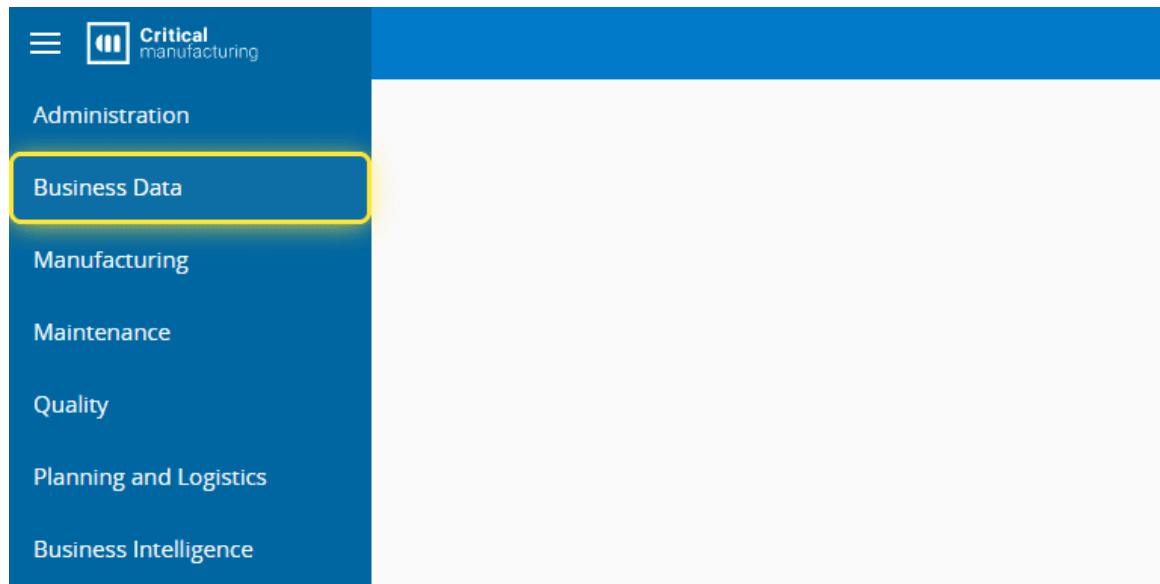

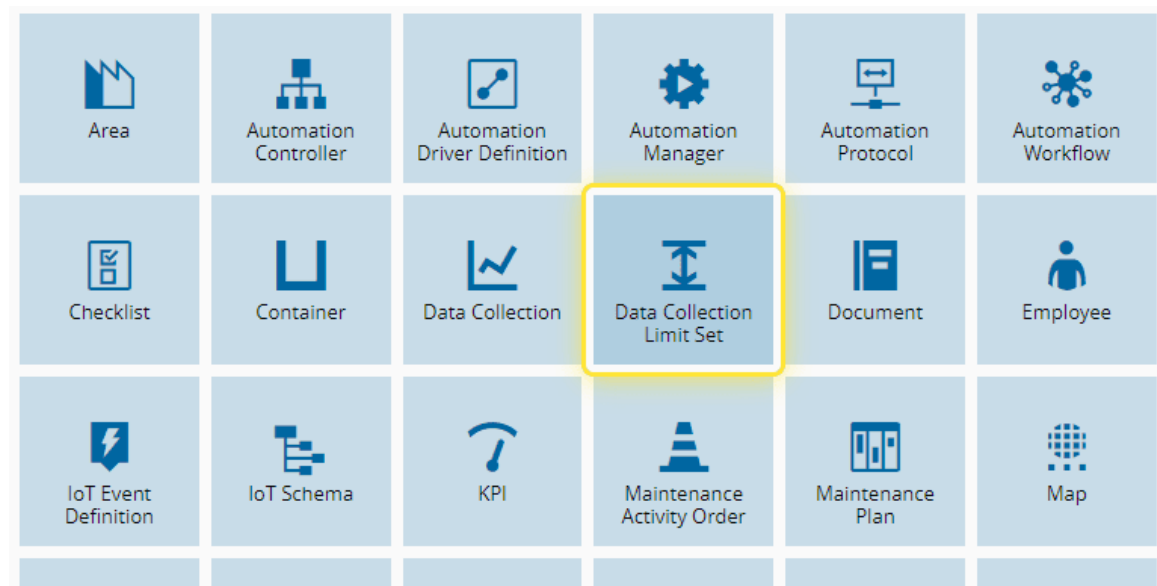

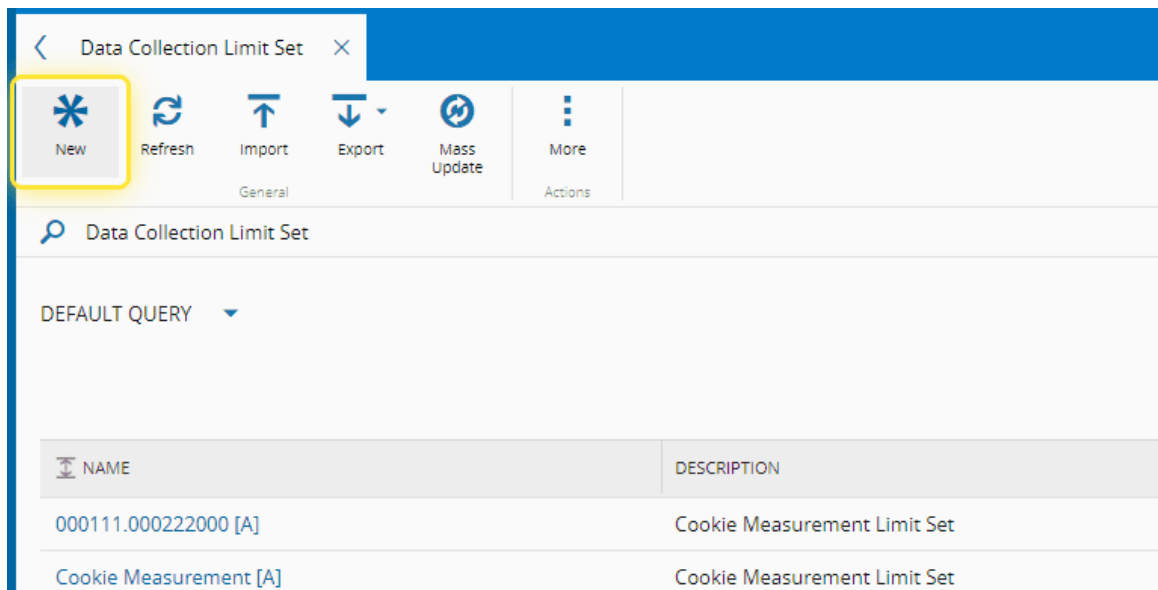
1. Go to the Business Data menu.



2. Select the Data Collection Limit Set entity.

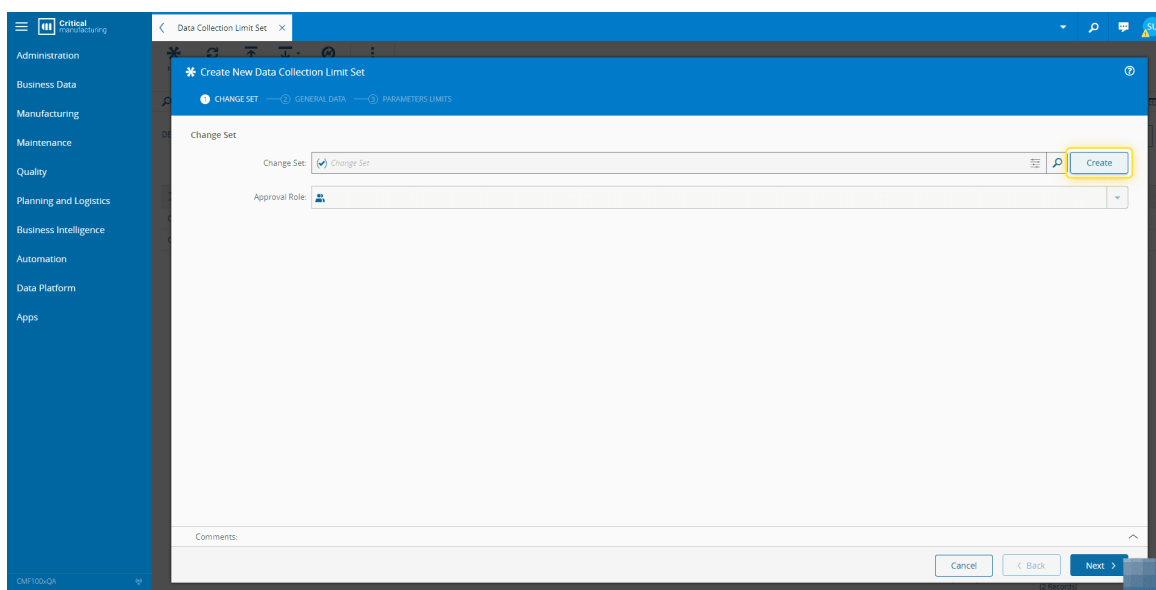


3. Select the New button.

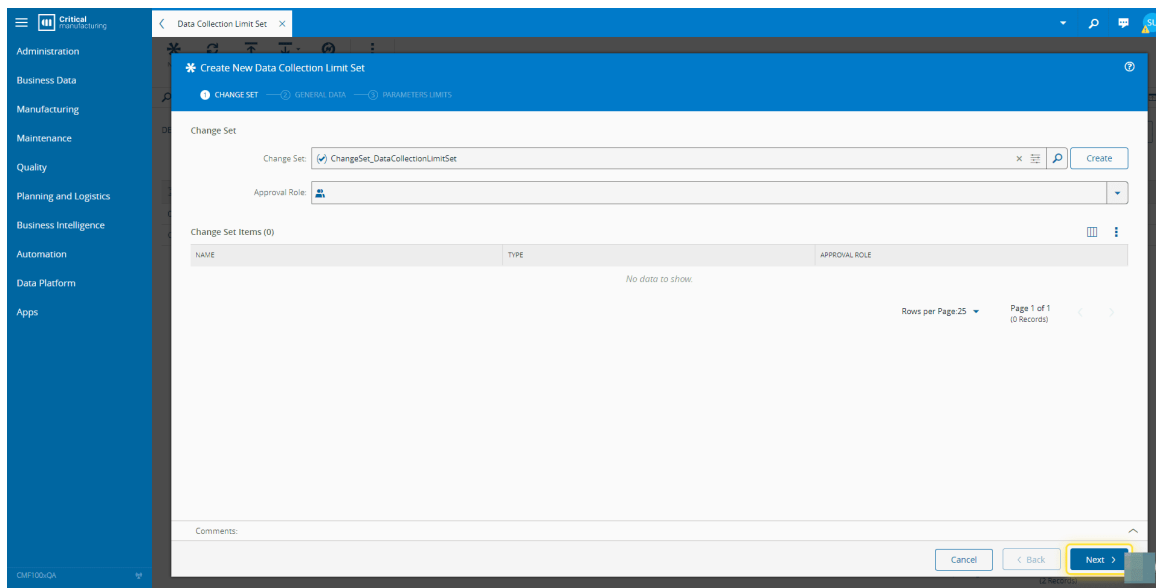
