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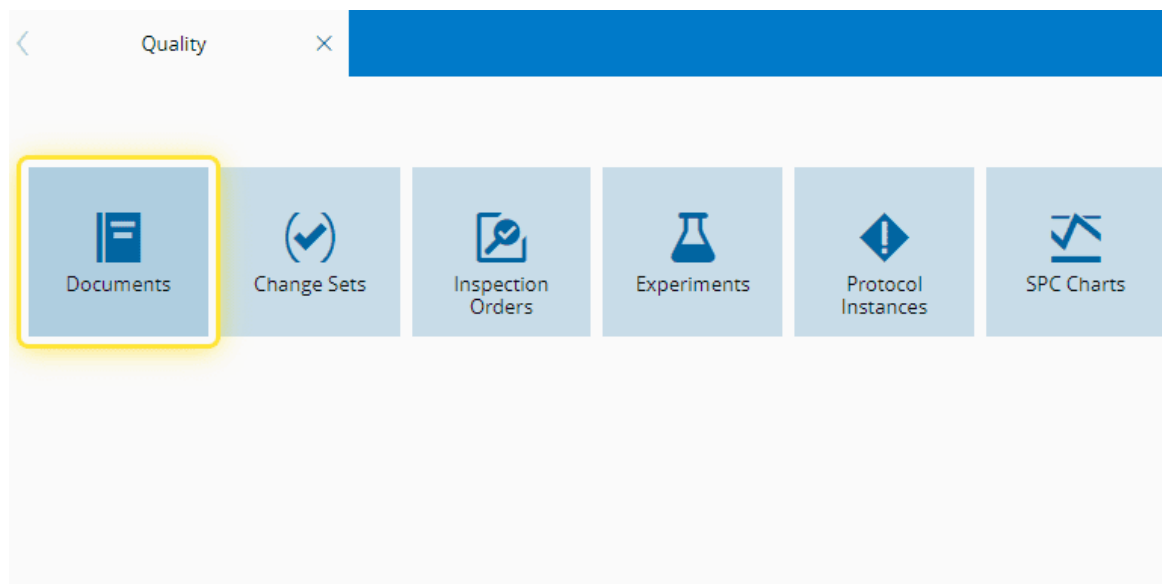
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How to: Create a Folder for a Document

1. Go to the Quality menu.

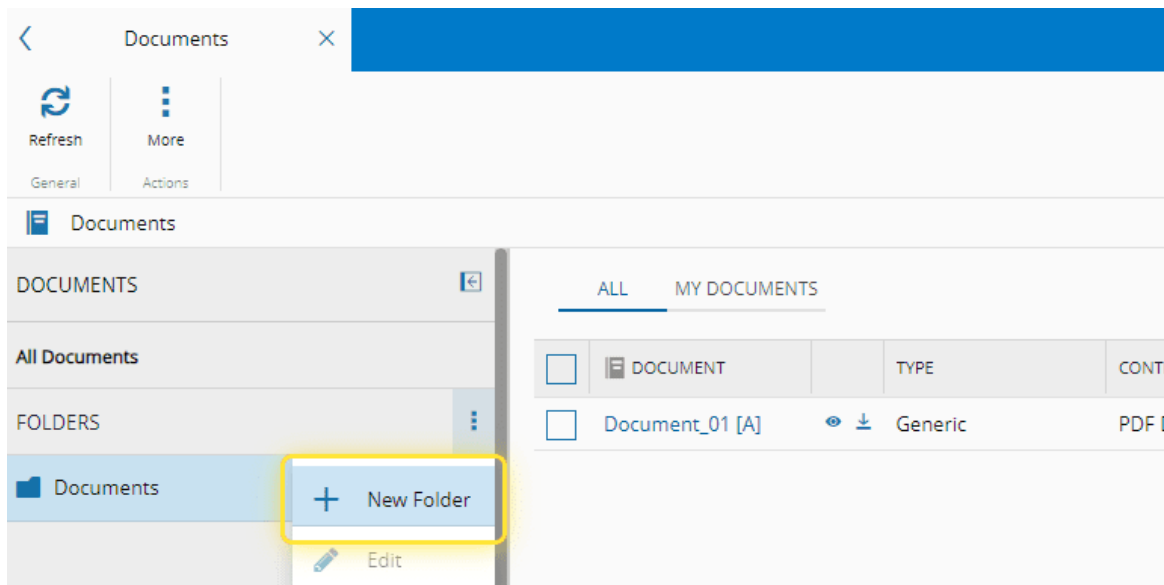


2. Select the Documents entity.



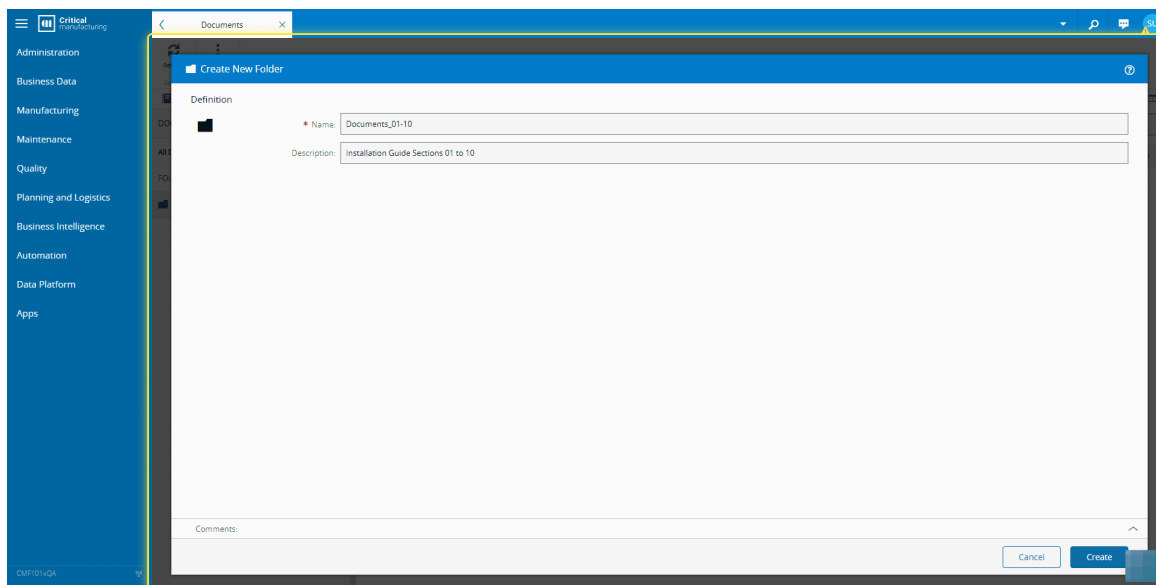
3. When in the Documents menu, select the More icon of the Folders menu, and select New Folder.
