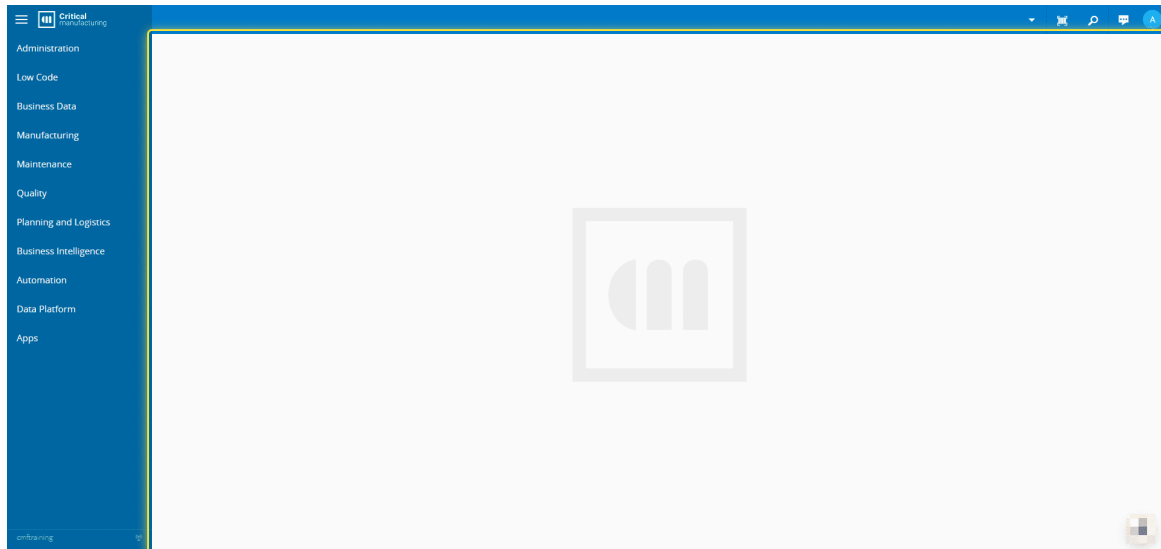

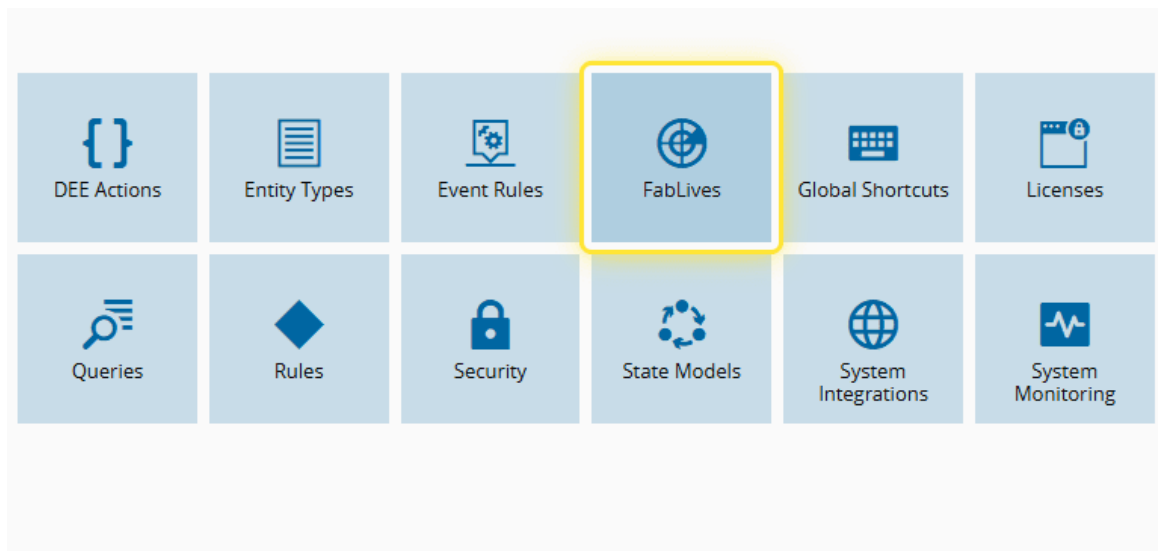
1. Go to your Critical Manufacturing MES installation.



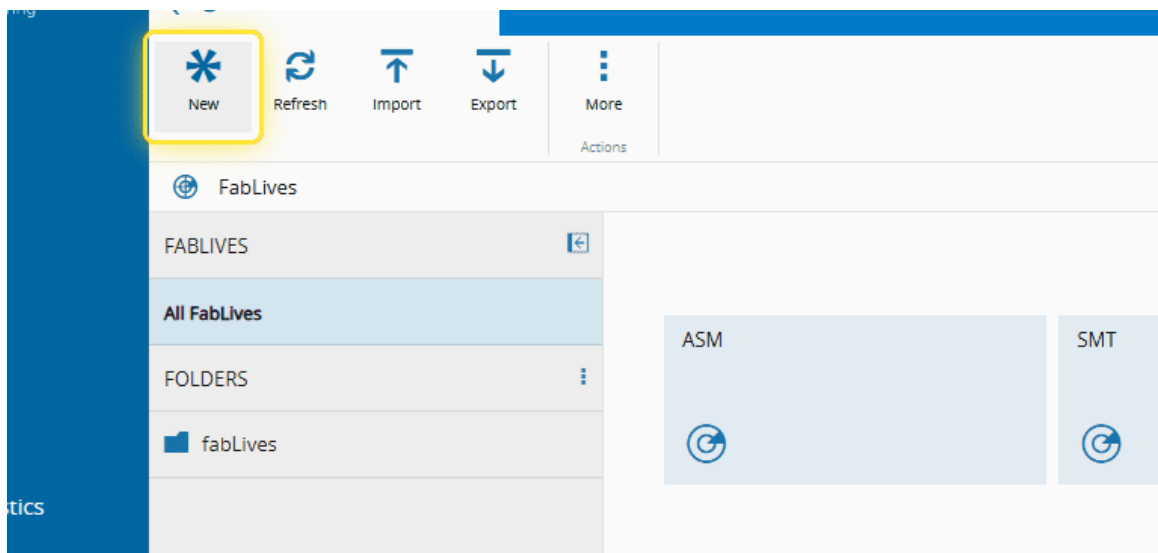
2. Select Administration.



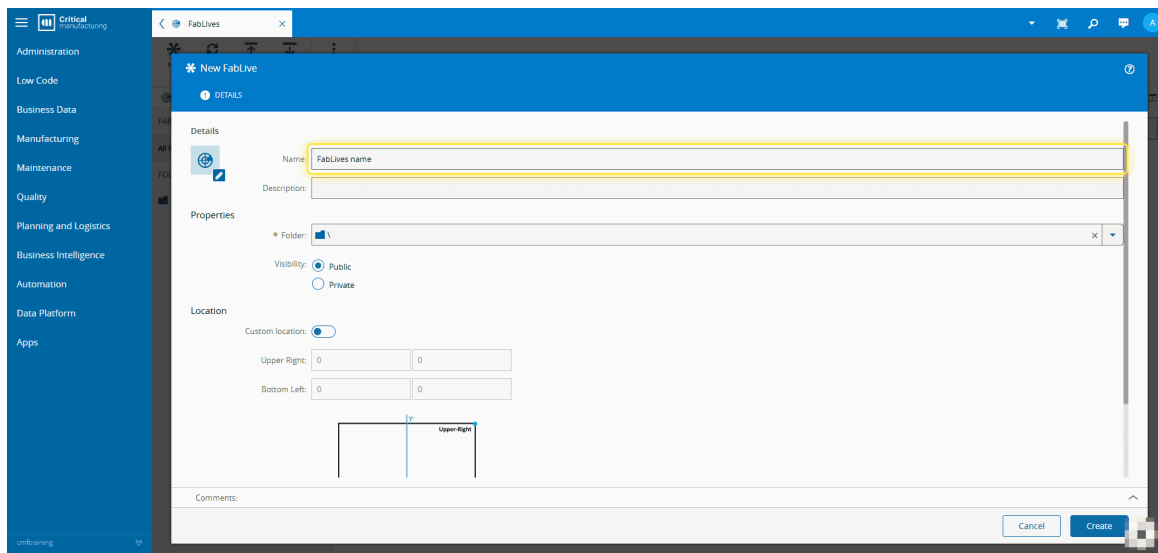
3. Select FabLives.



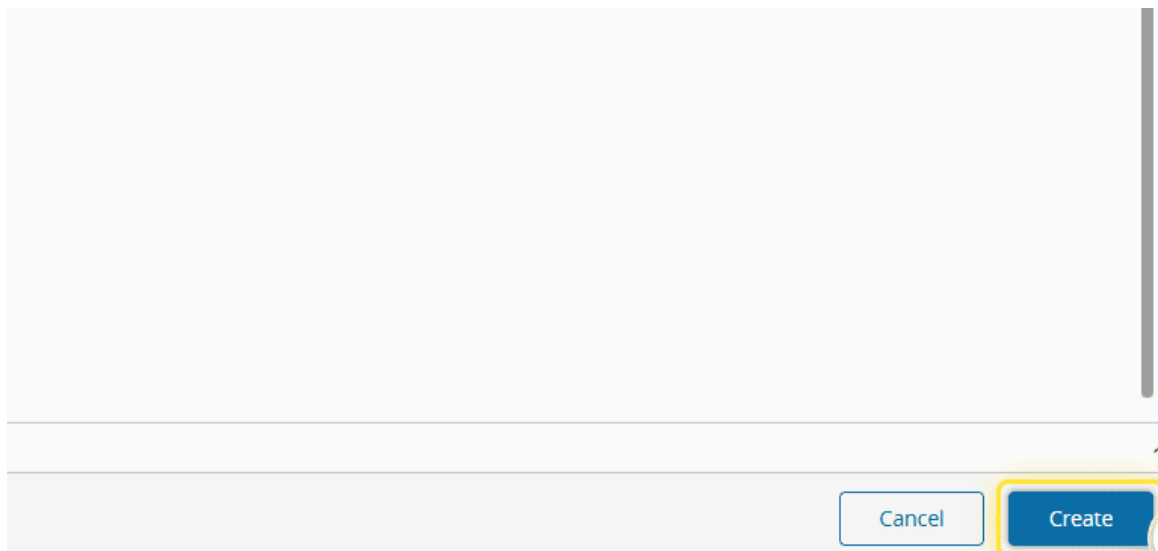
4. Select New.
