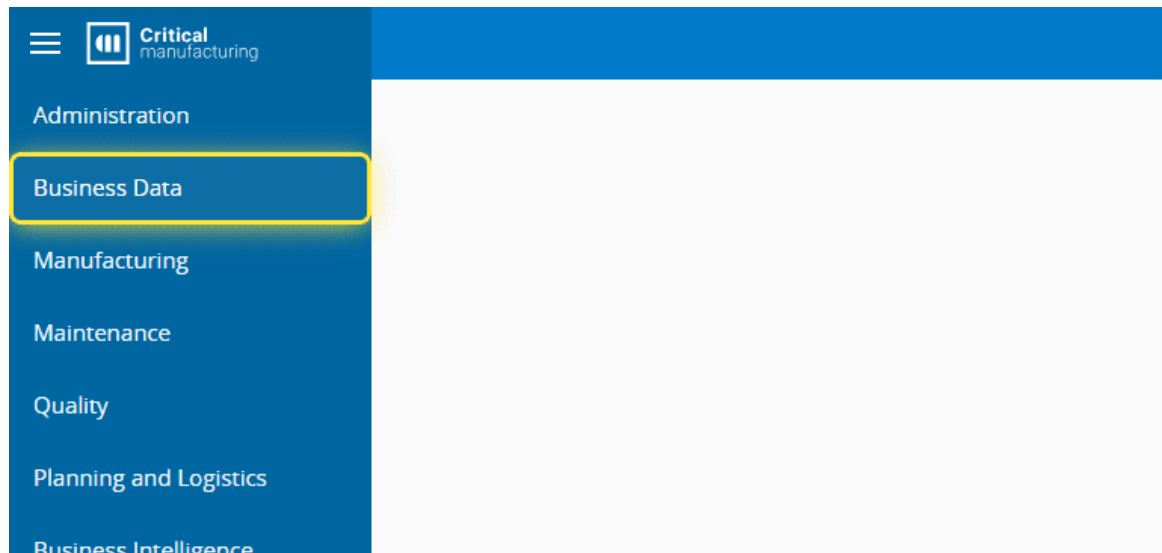

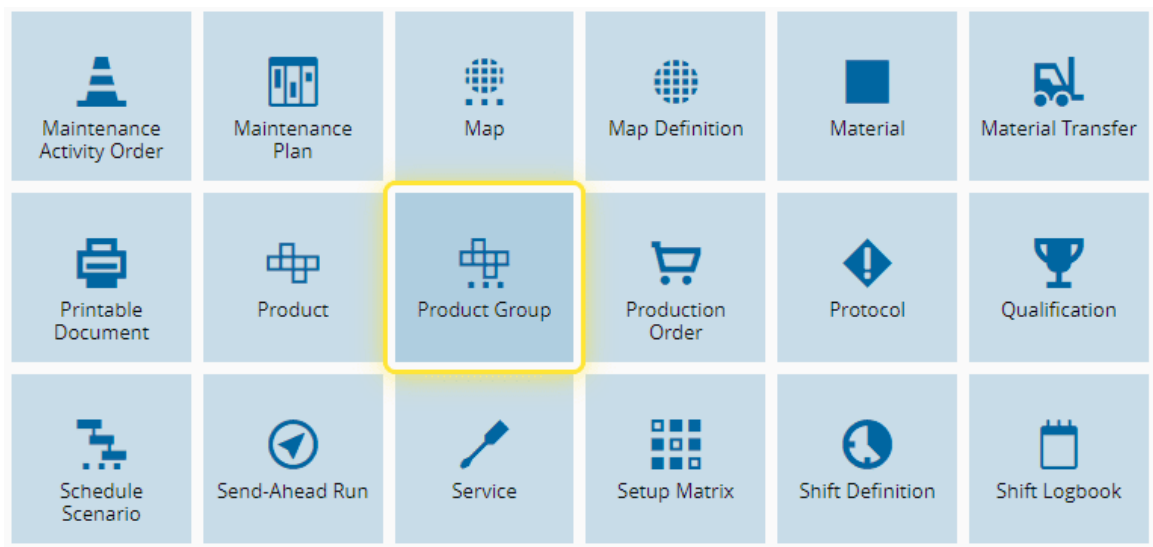

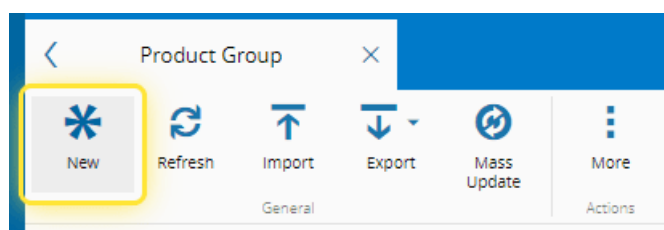
1. Go to the Business Data menu.



2. Select the Product Group Entity.

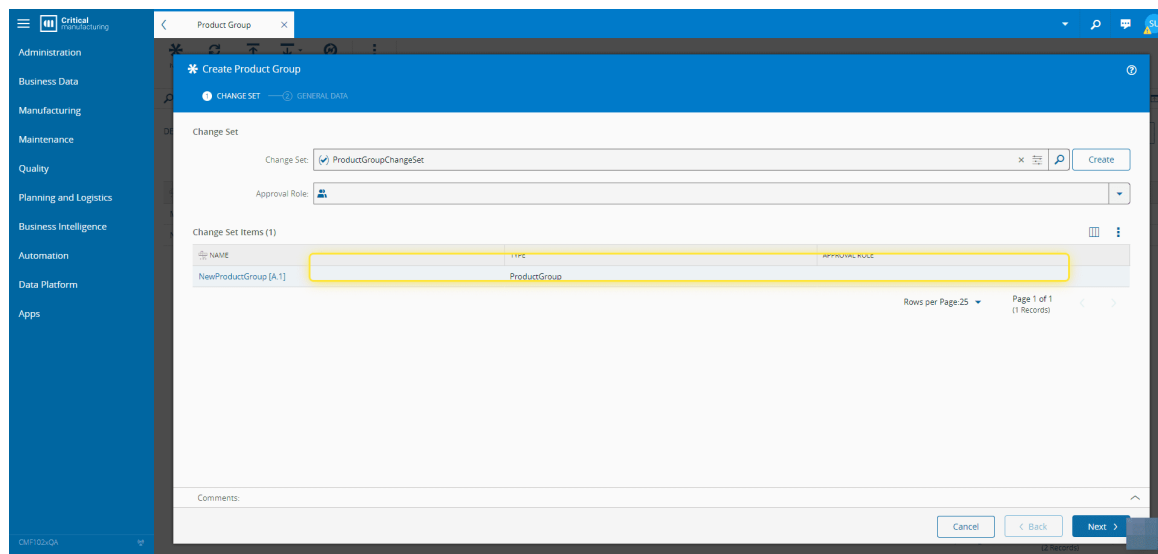


3. Select the New button.

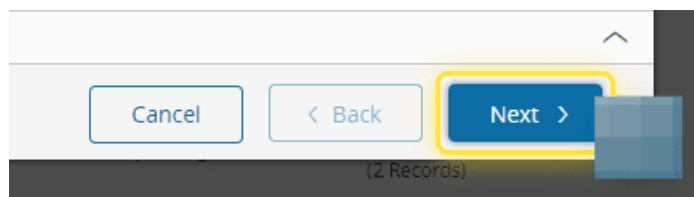

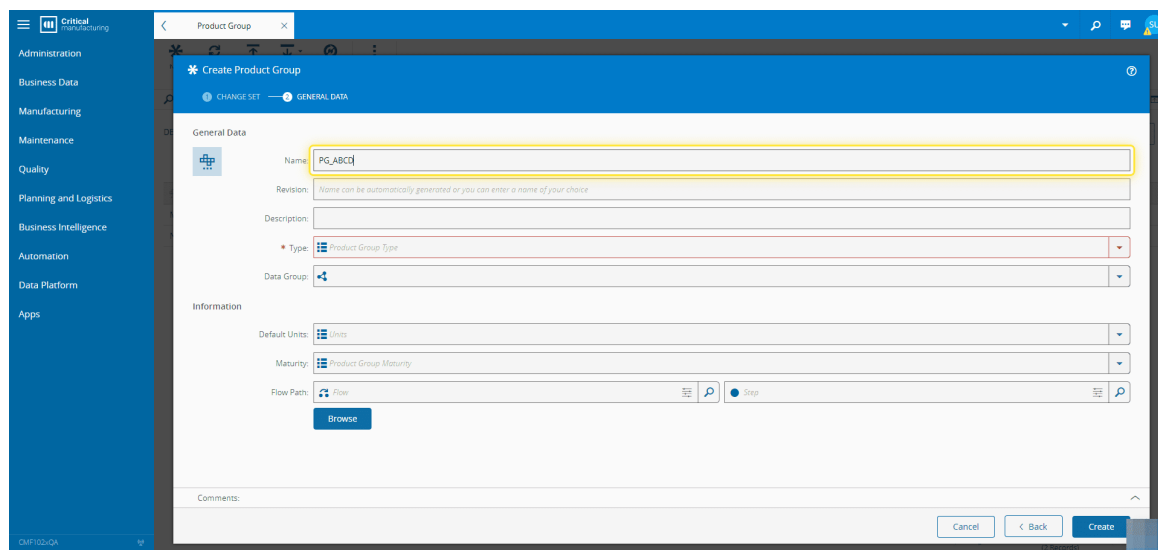
