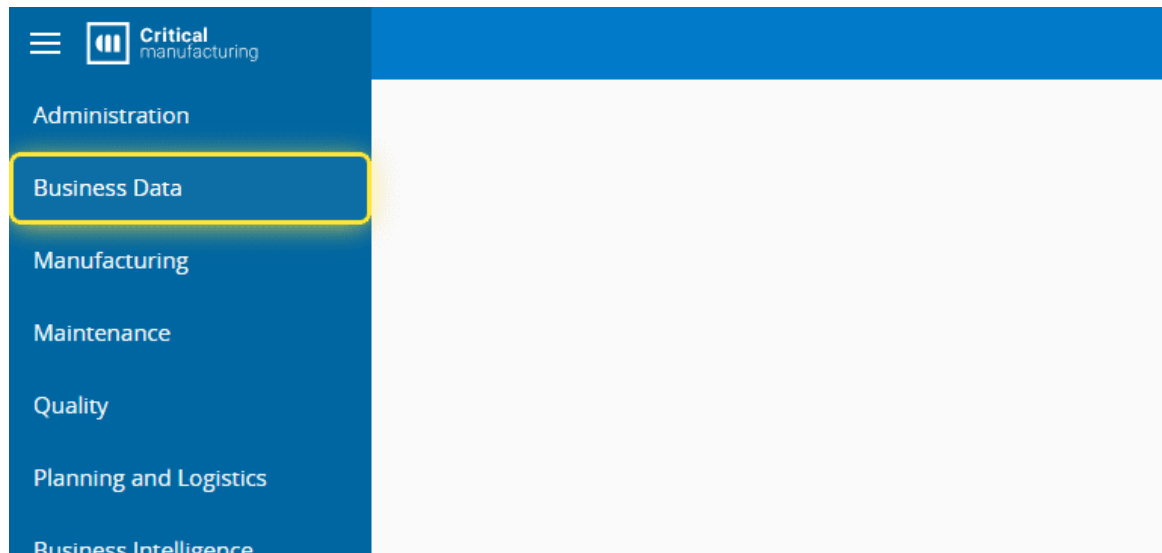
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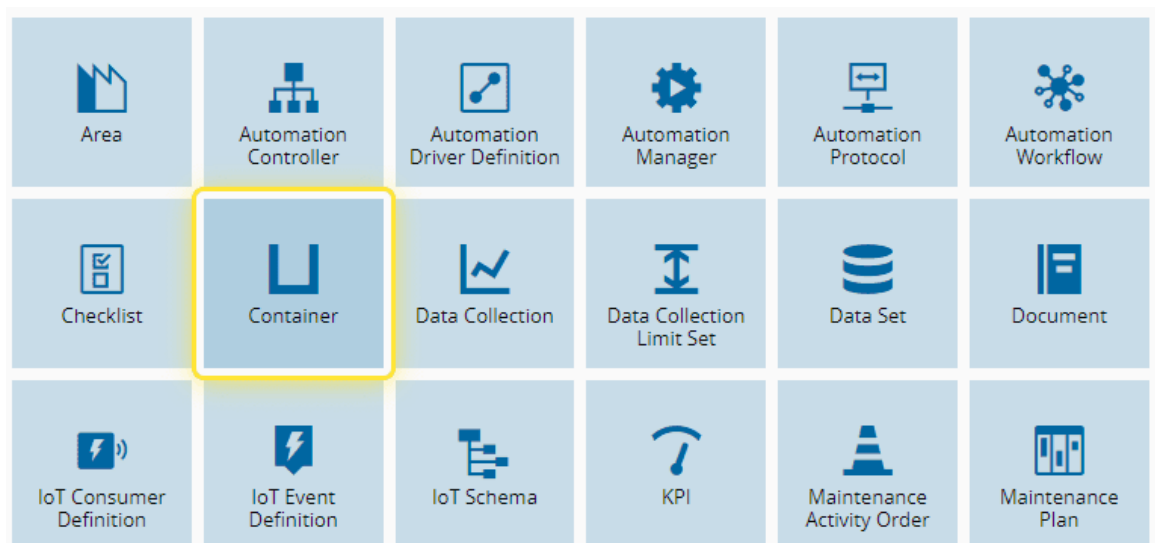
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How to: Empty a Container

2. Select the Container entity.



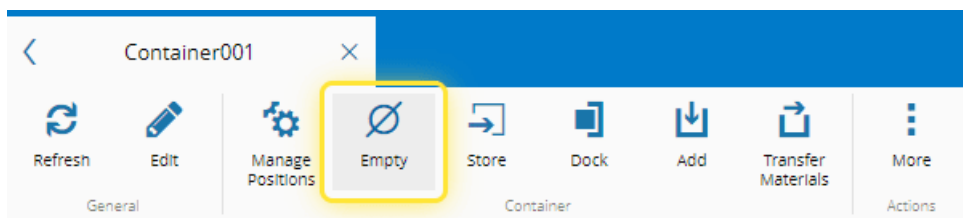
3. Select the desired container.
