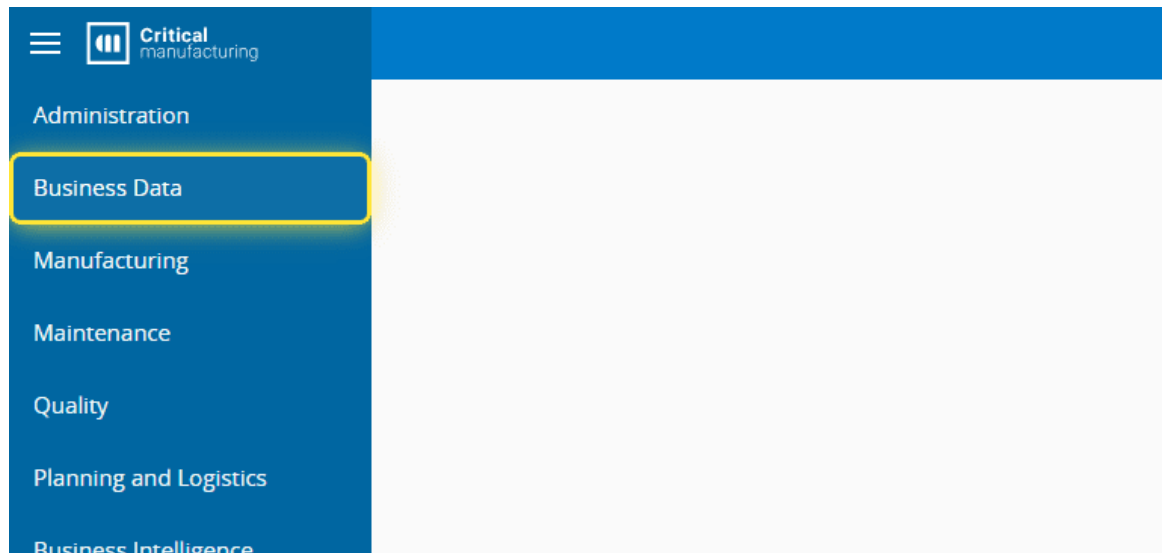
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How to: Grade a Material

2. Select the Material entity.



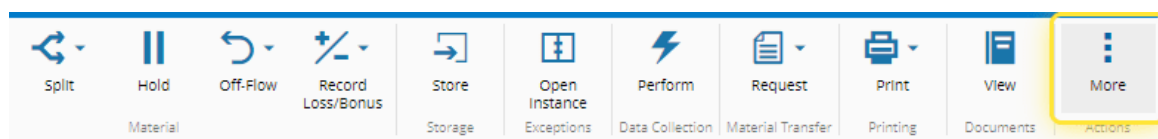
3. Select the desired Material.

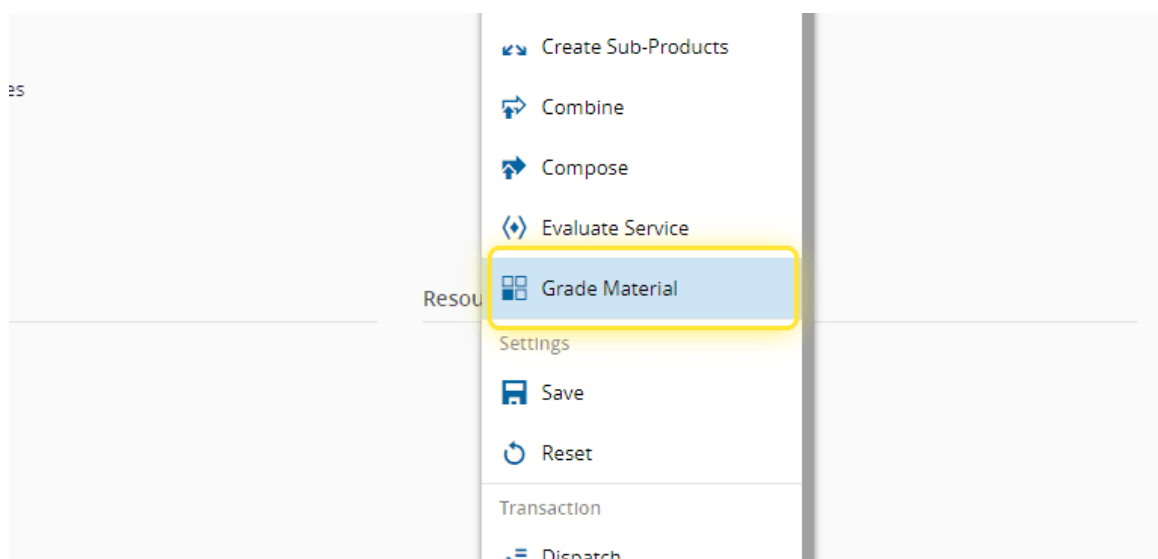
