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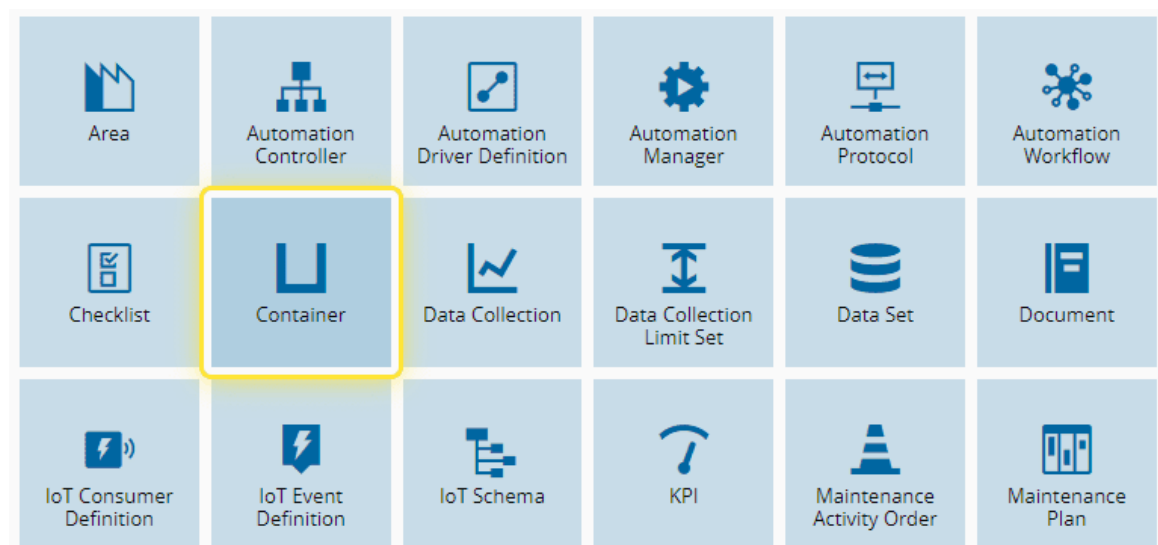
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How to: Transfer Material Between Containers

2. Select the Container button.



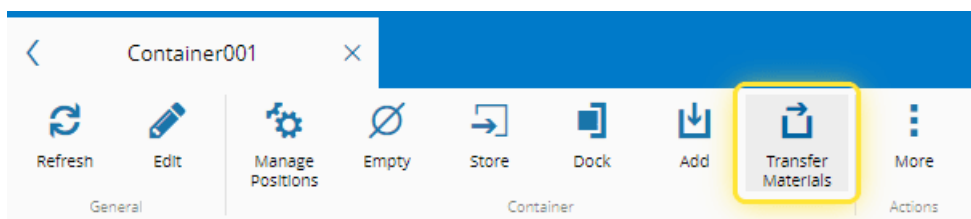
3. Select the desired Container.

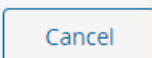
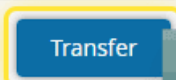
