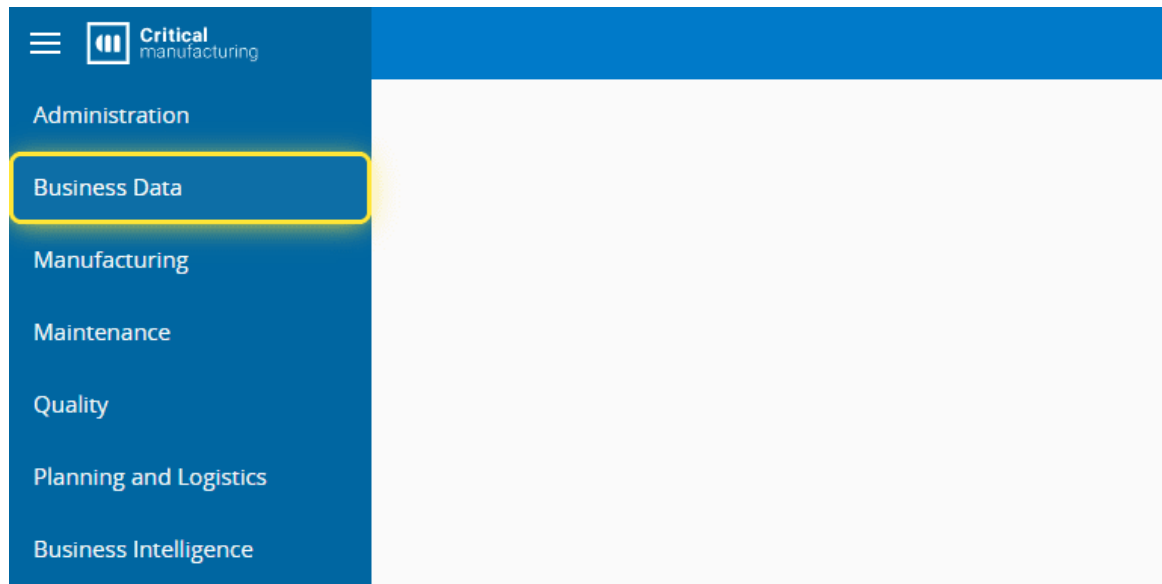

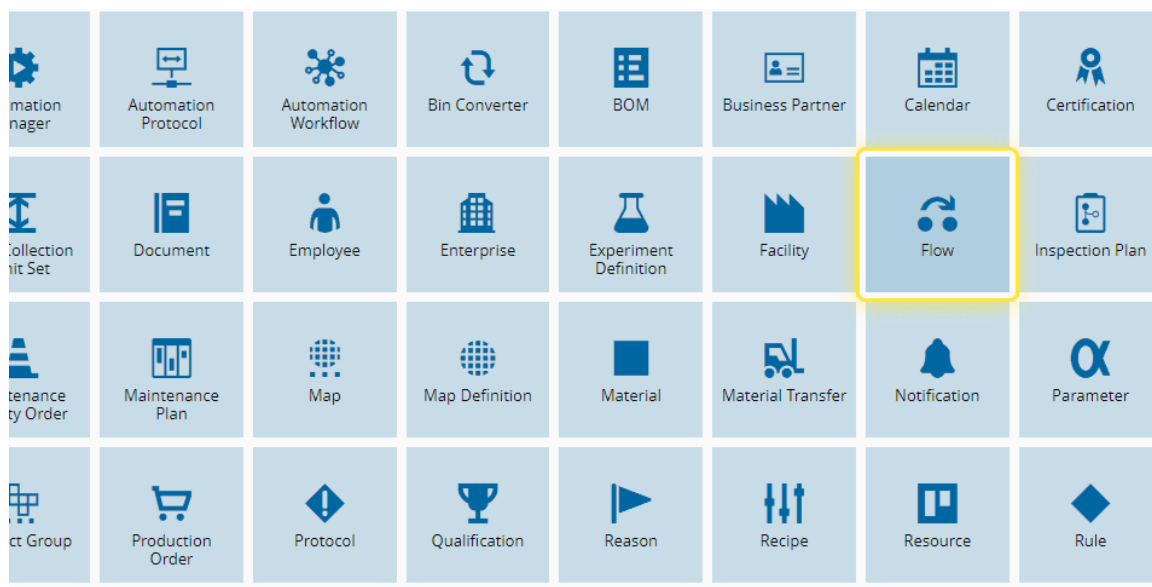
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How to: Create a Flow

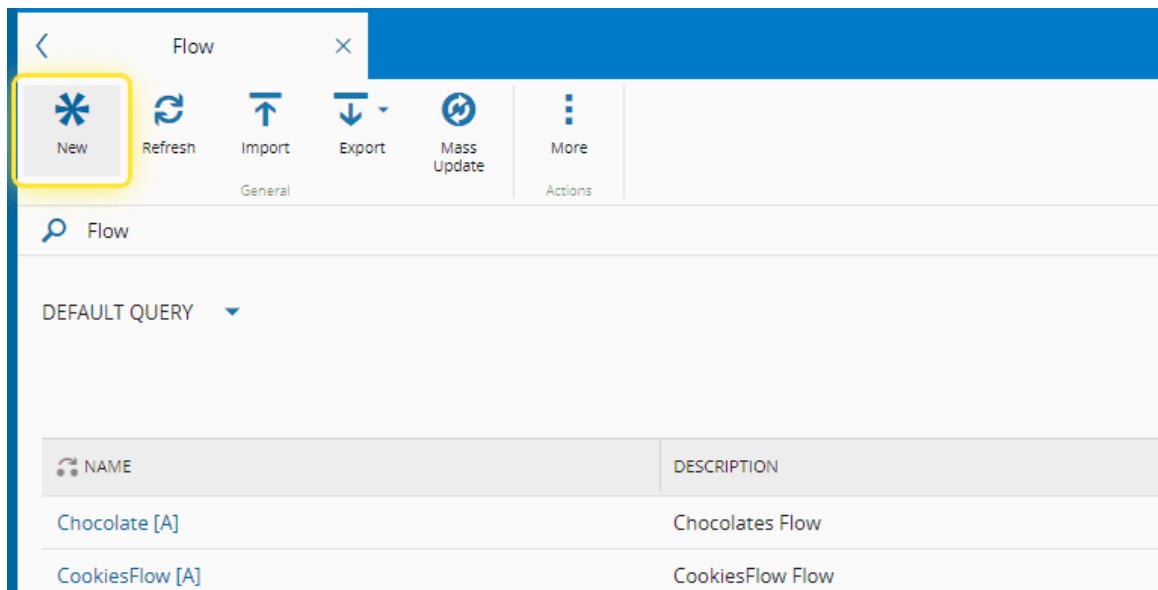
1. Go to the Business Data menu.



2. Select the Flow entity.

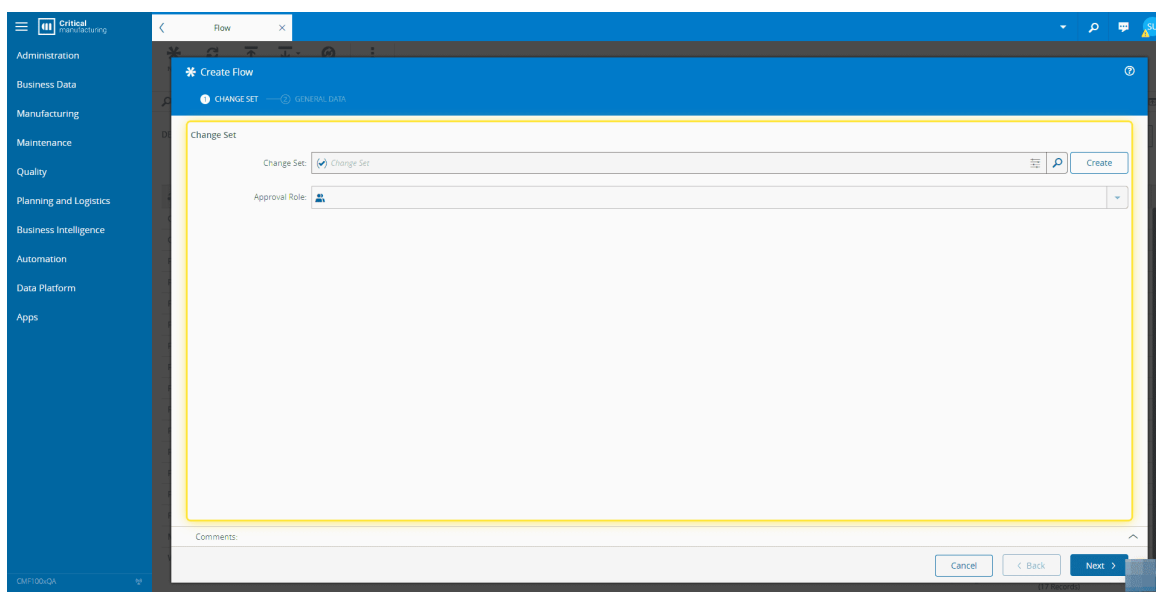


3. Select the New button.

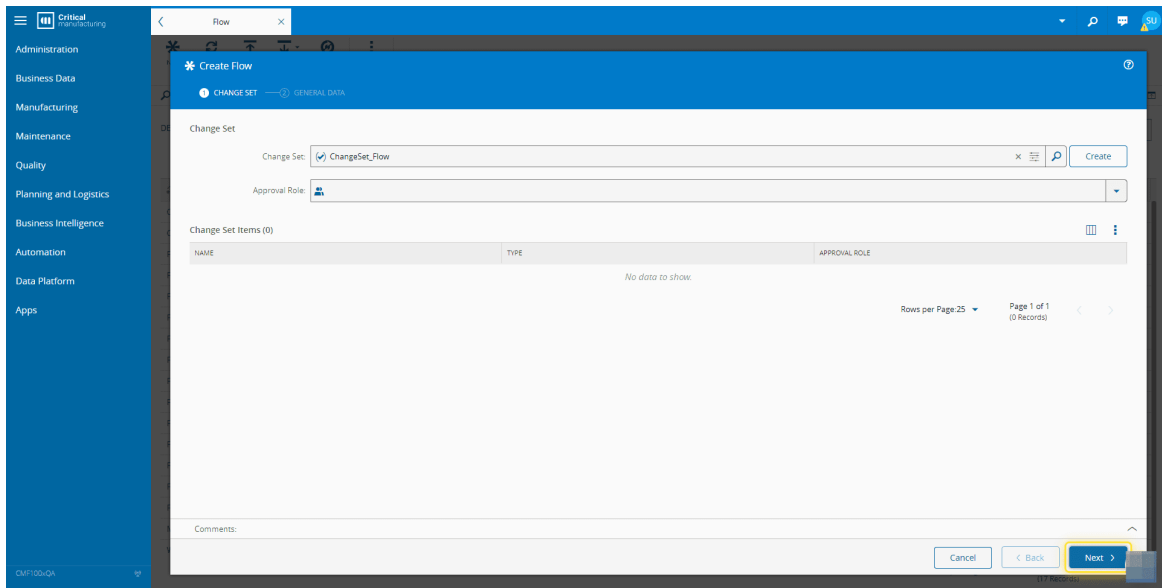


4. Under the Change Set tab, select an existing Change Set or Create a new one.

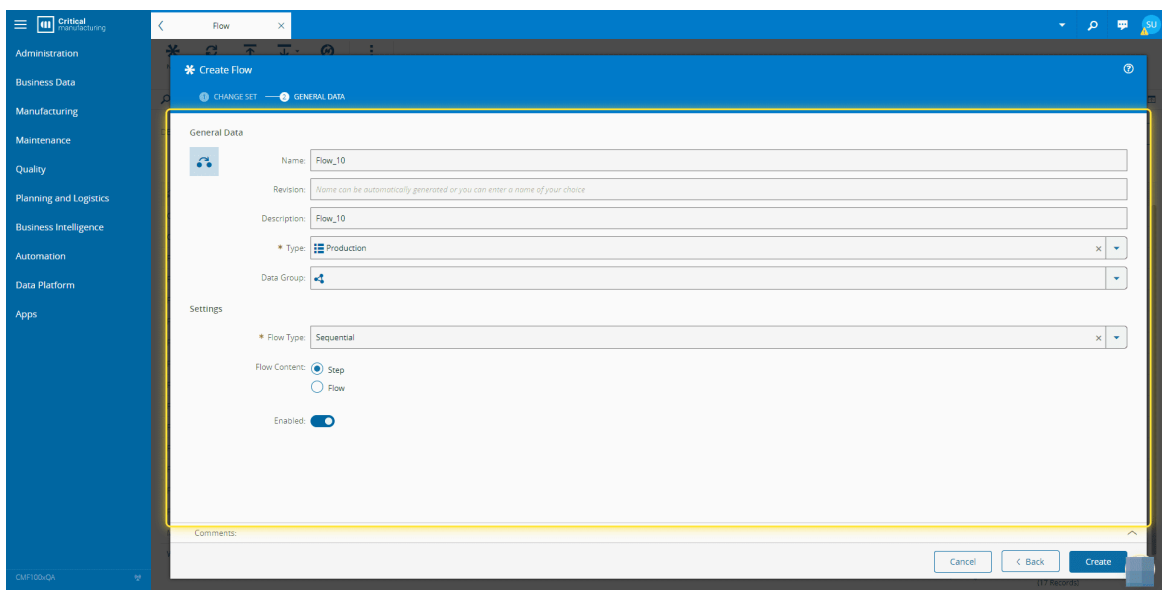


5. Select the Next button.

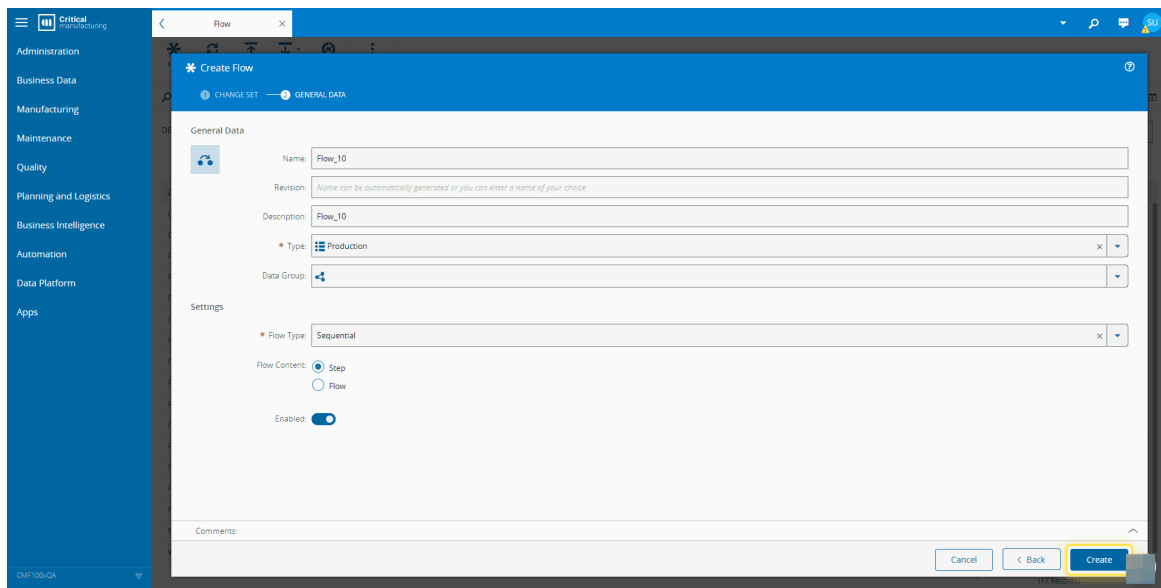


6. Under the General Data tab, complete the necessary fields.

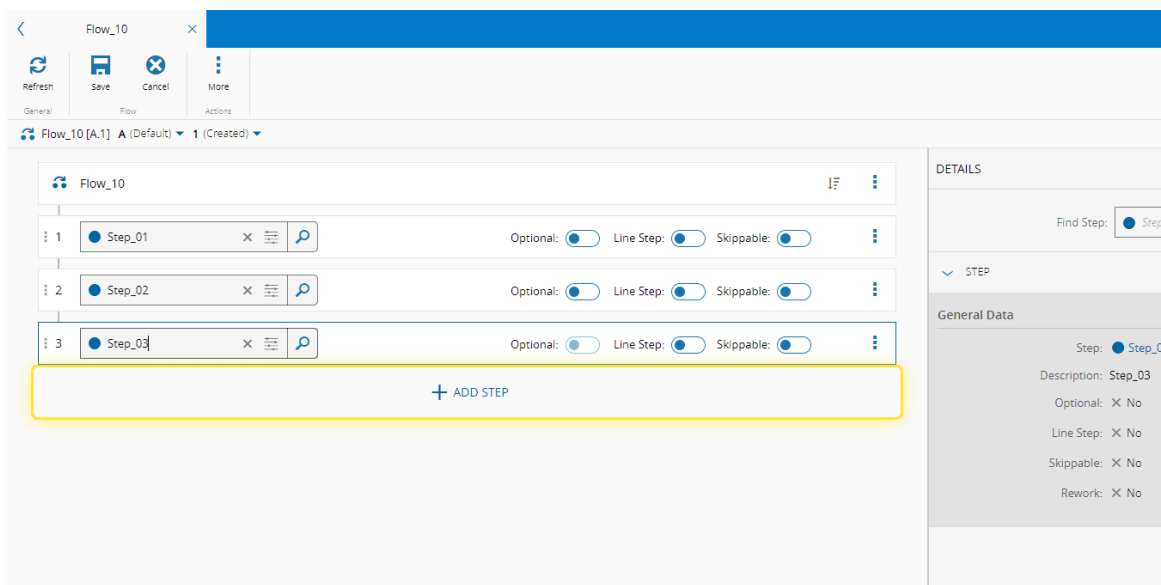
