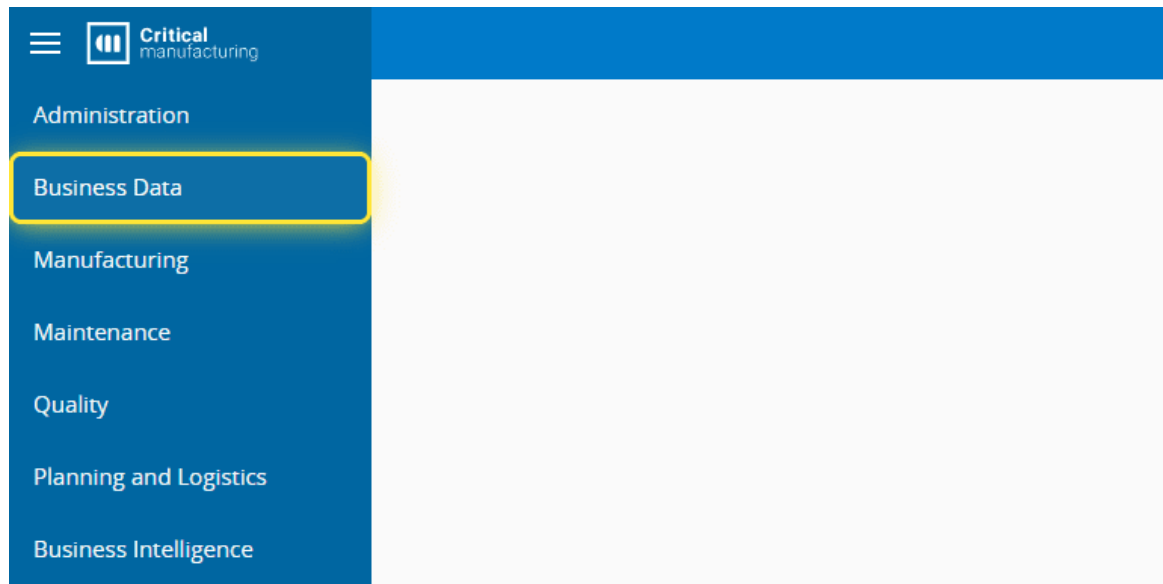

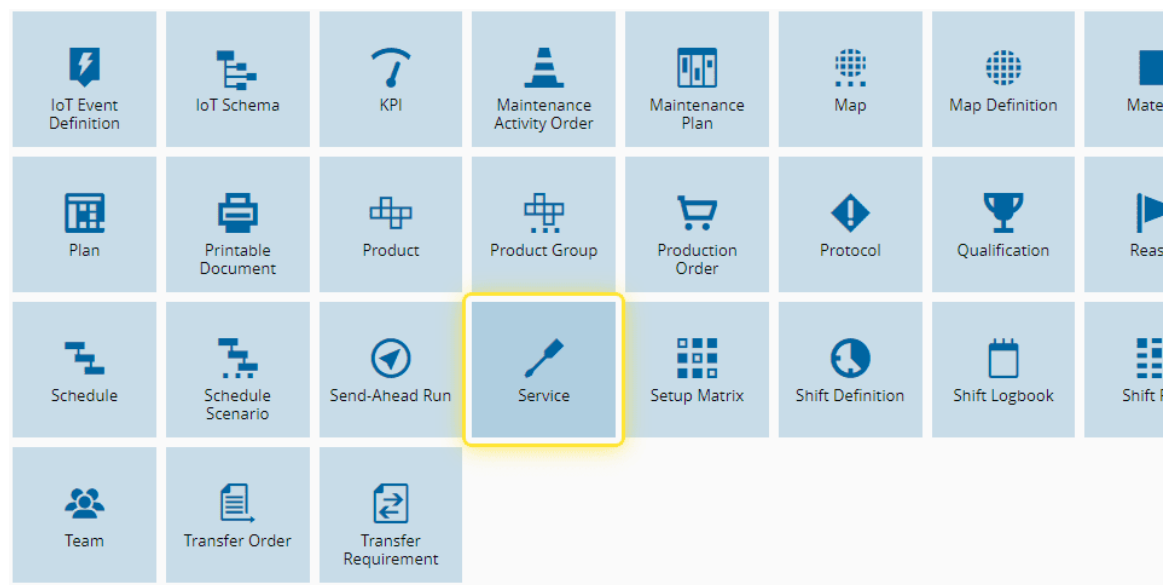

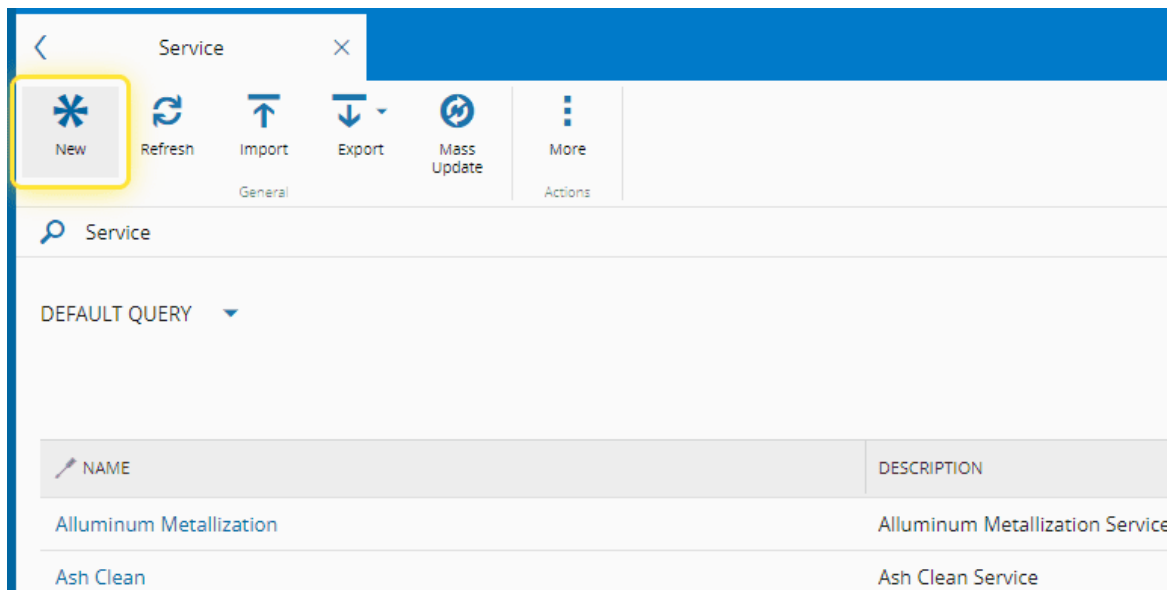
1. Go to the Business Data menu.



2. Select the Service entity.

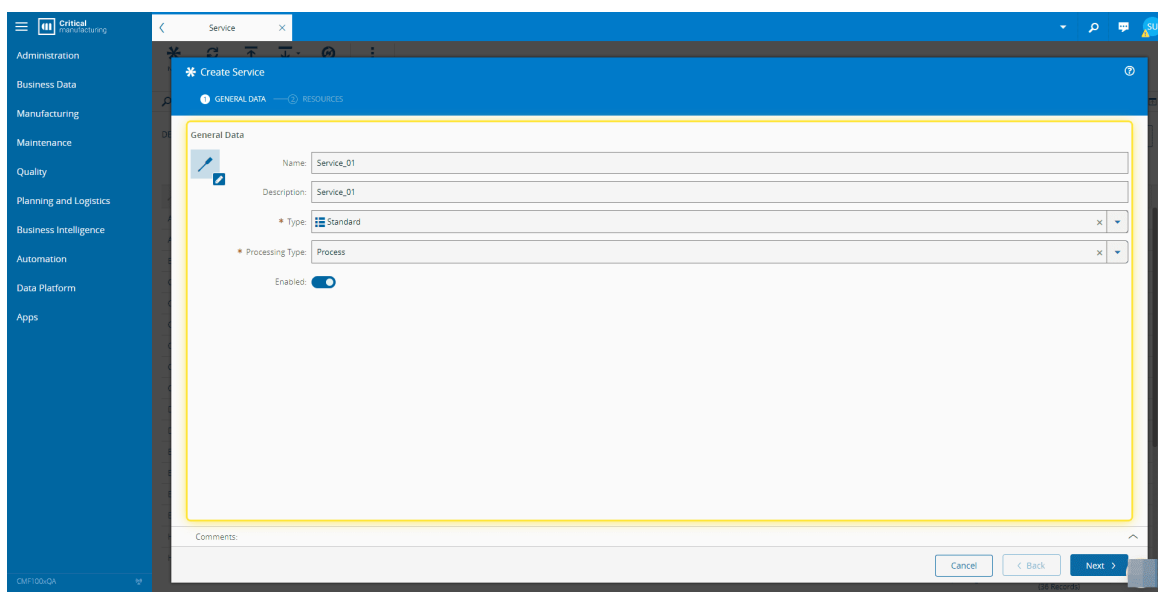


3. Select the New button.

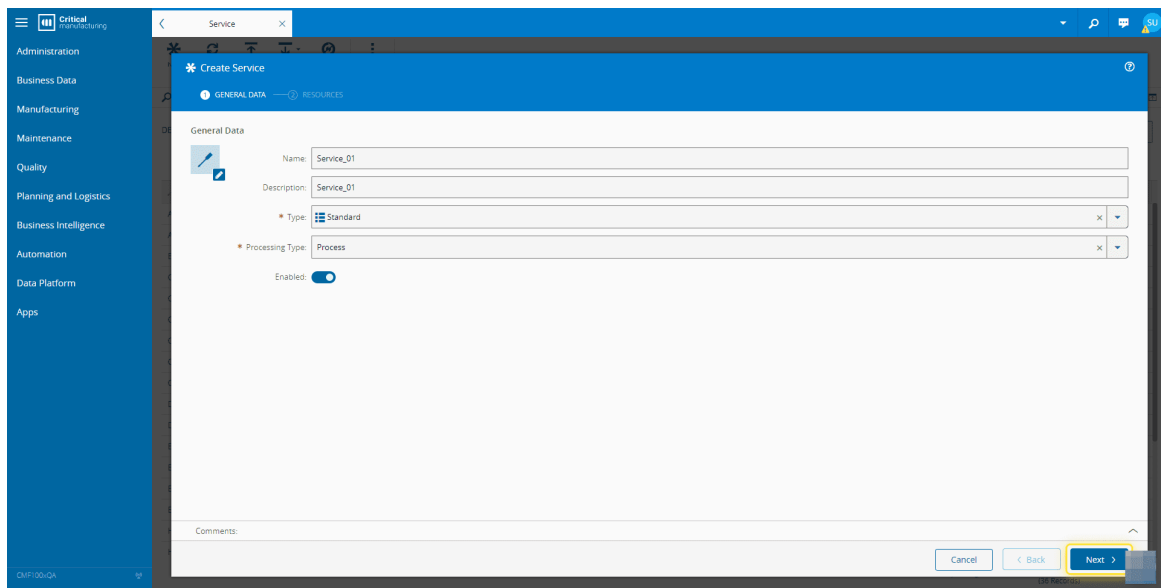


4. Under the General Data tab, complete the necessary fields.

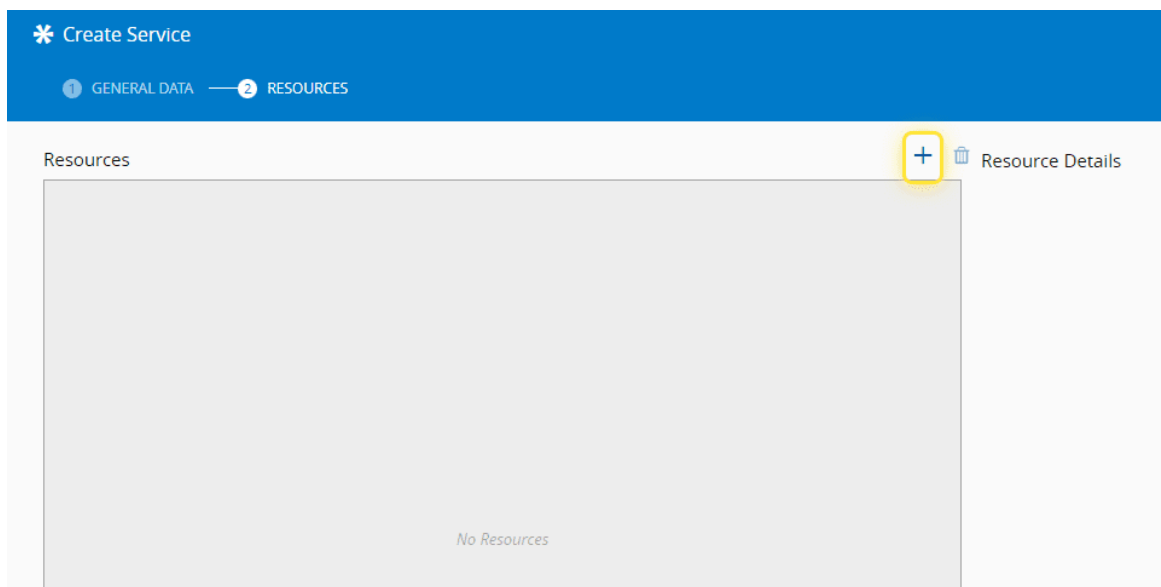

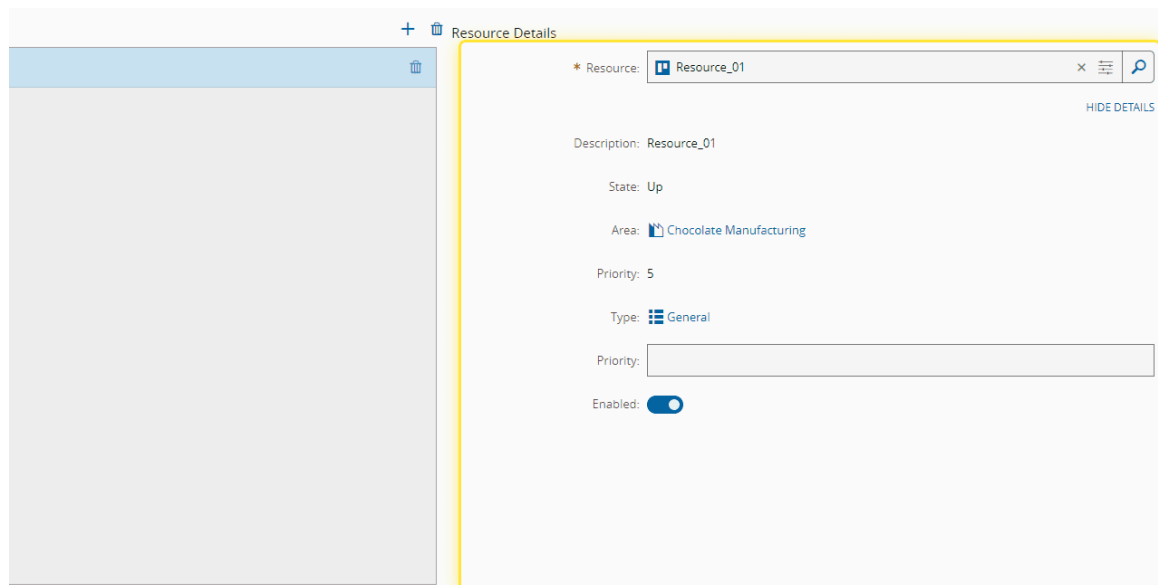

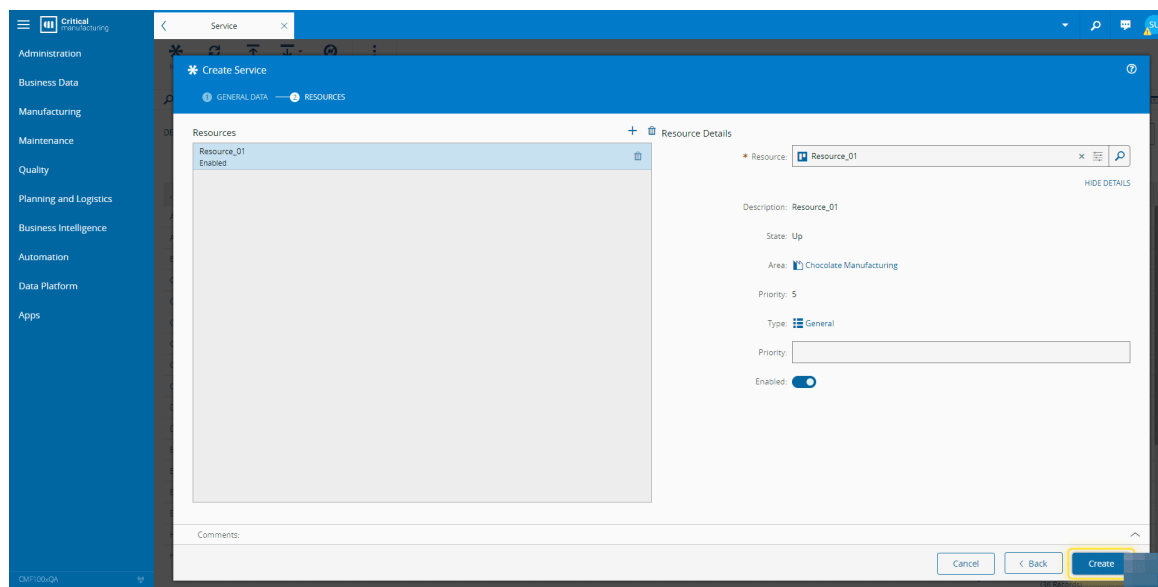
