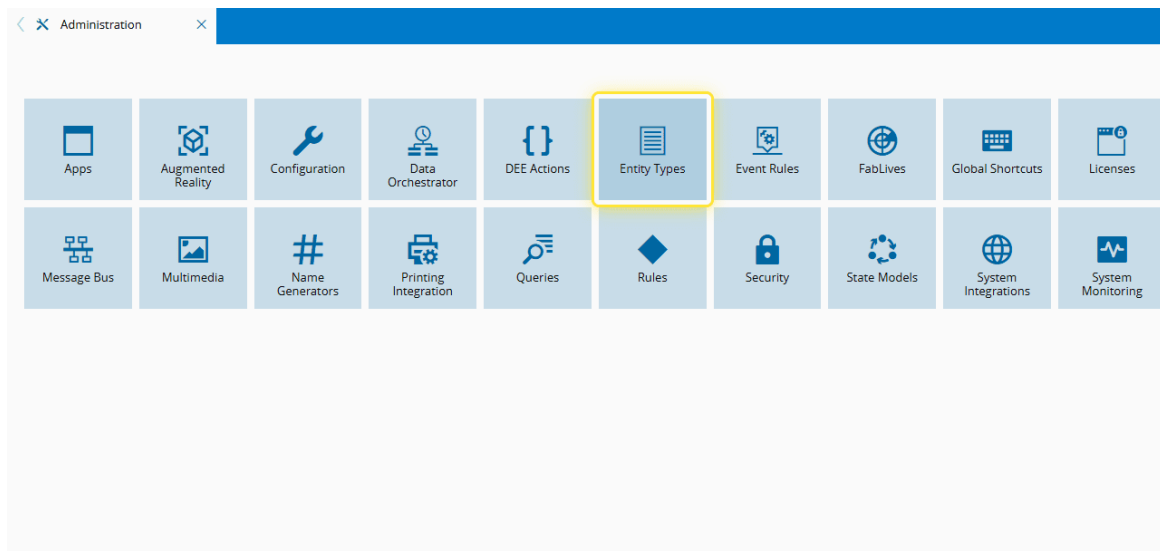


1. Go to the Administration menu.



2. Select the Entity Types option.




3. Select the Entity you need.

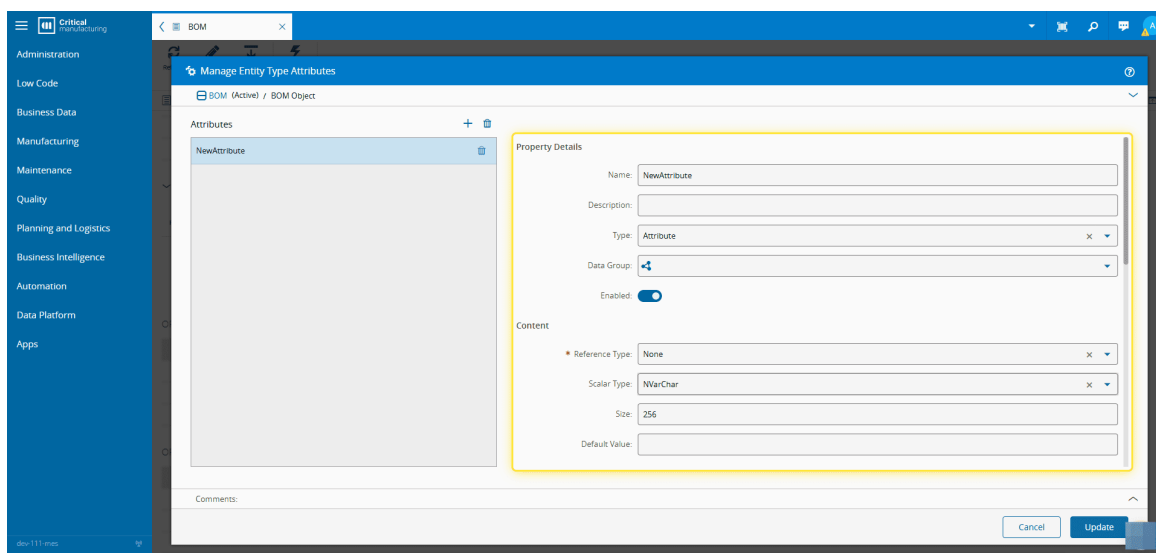
