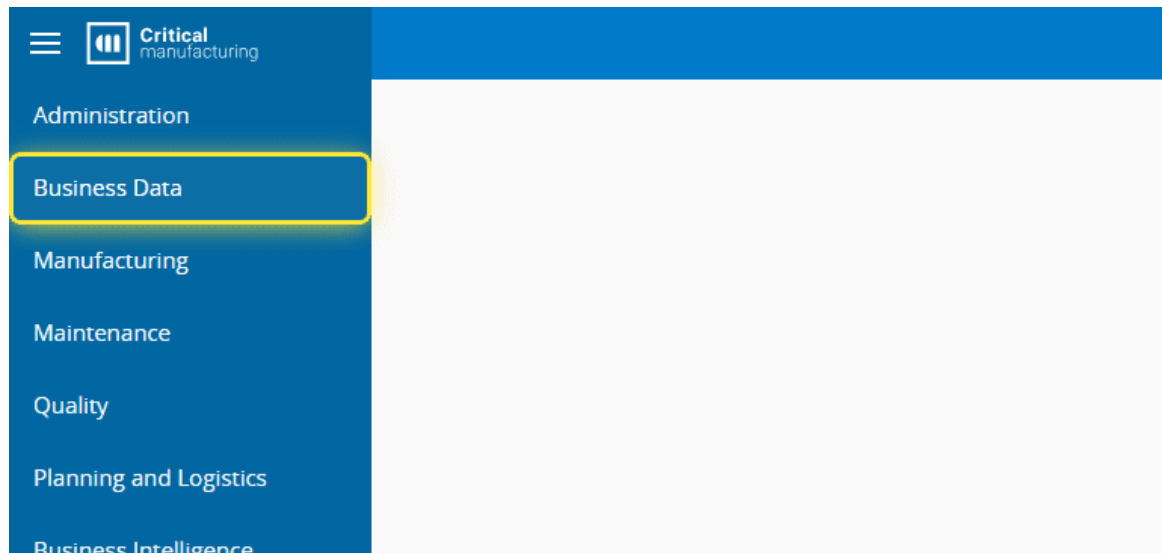
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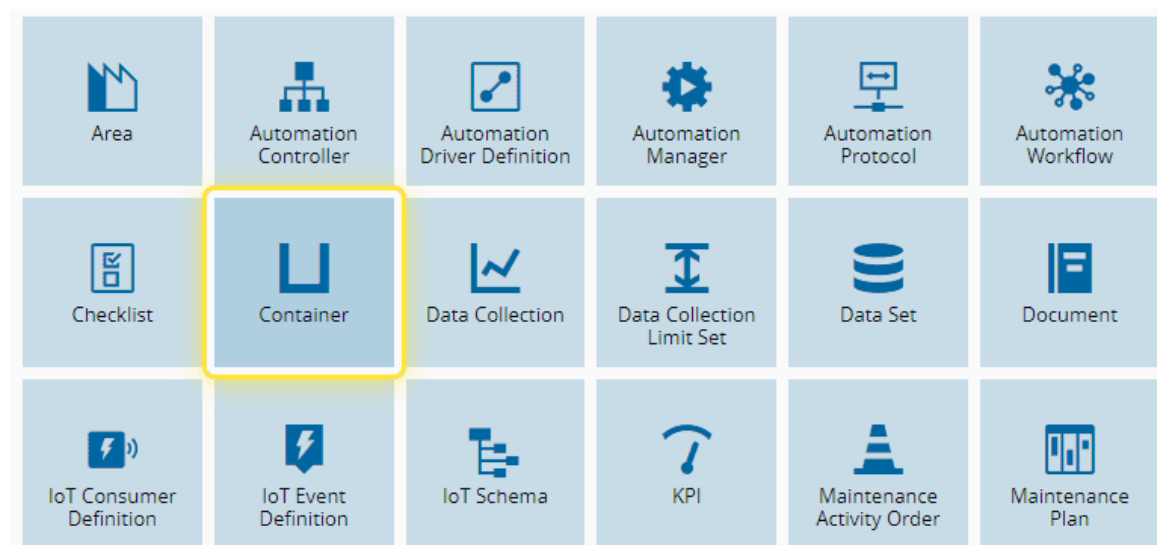
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How to: Manage Container Positions

1. Go to the Business Data menu.



2. Select the Container entity.



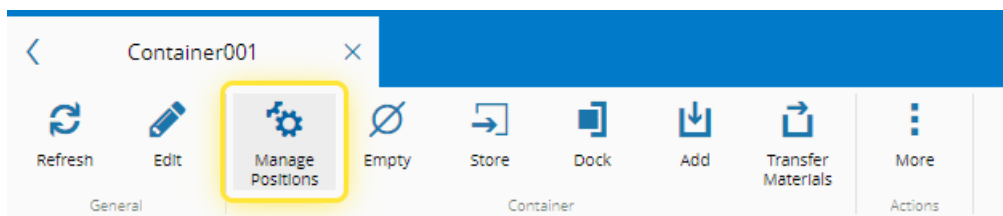
3. Select the desired Container.

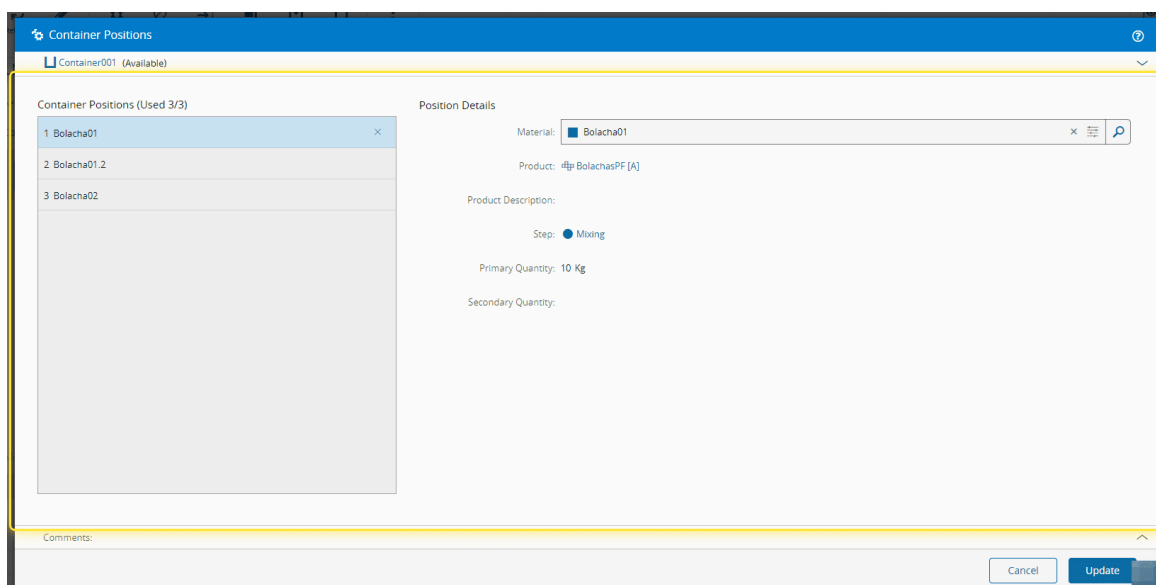
4. Select the Manage Positions button.
