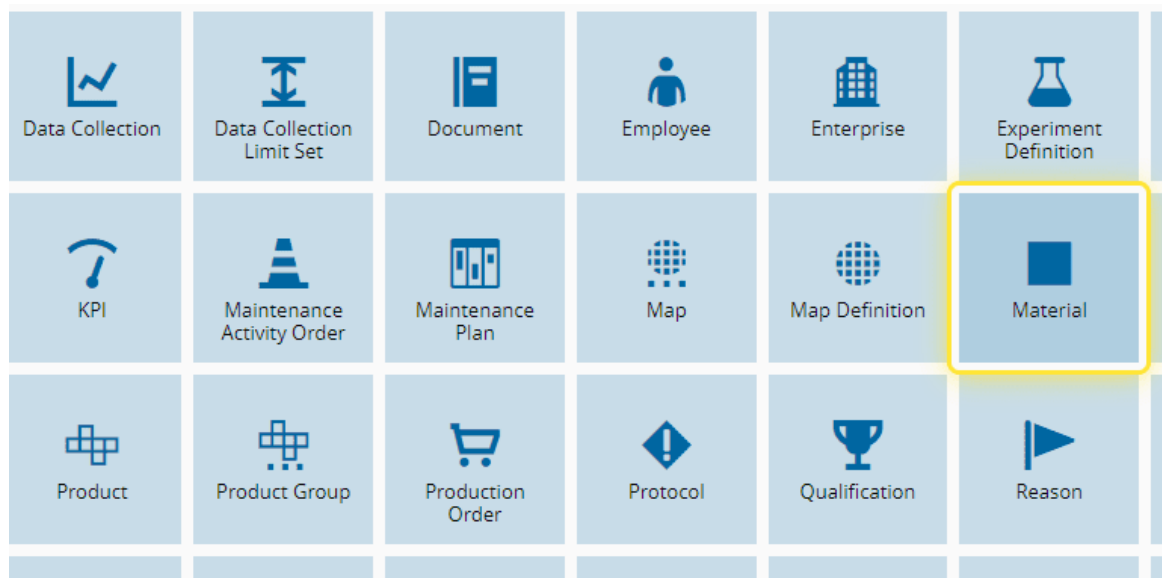
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How to: Track-Out

1. Go to the Business Data menu.

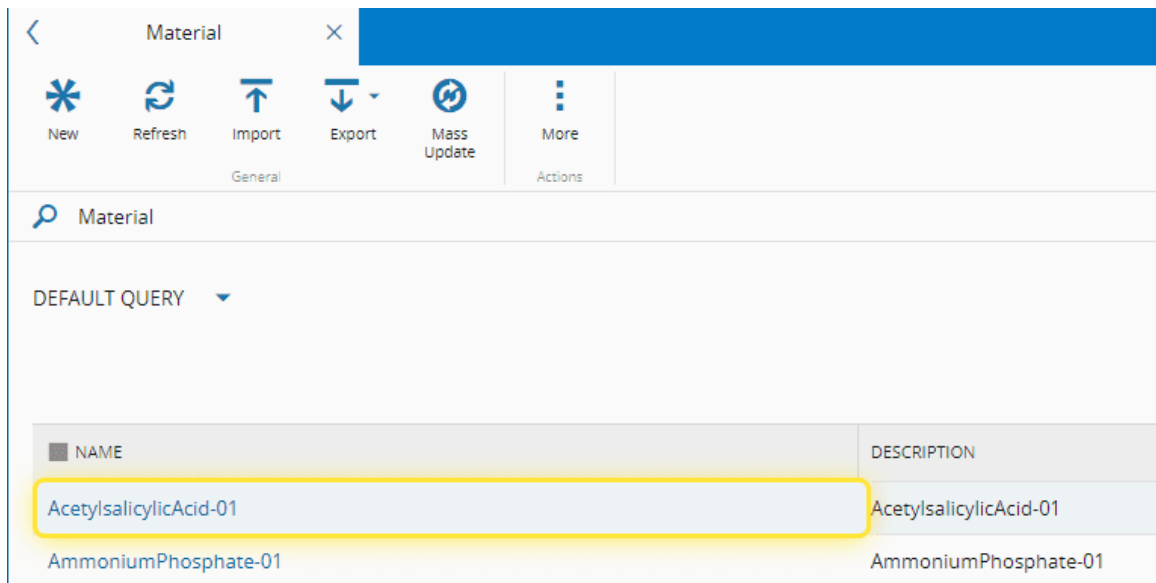


2. Select the Material entity.



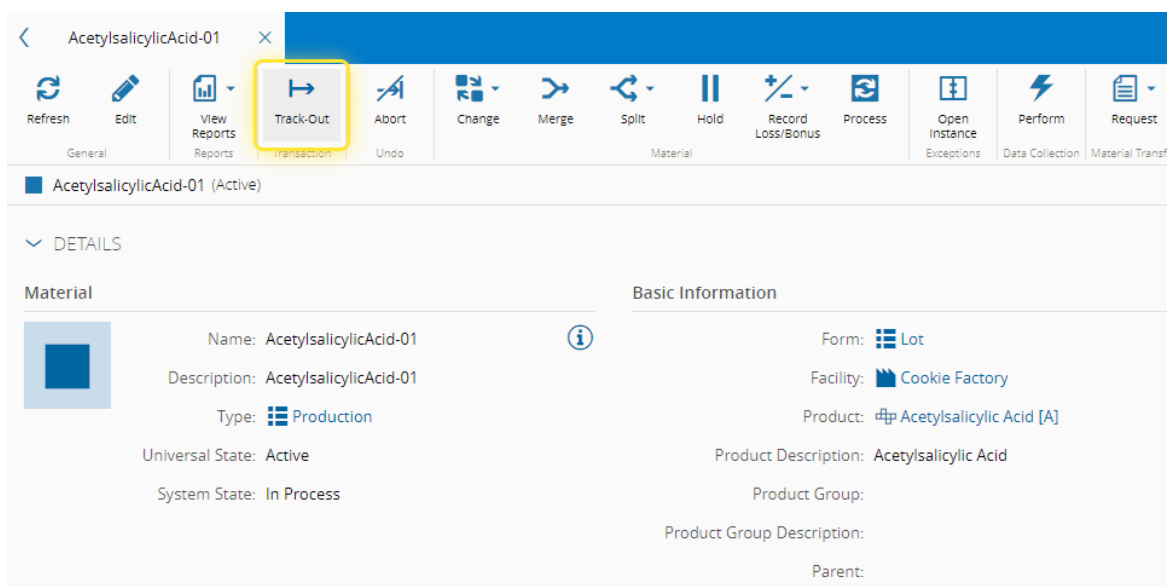
3. Select a Material.

The material selection can be done this way, or through Step or Resource View.

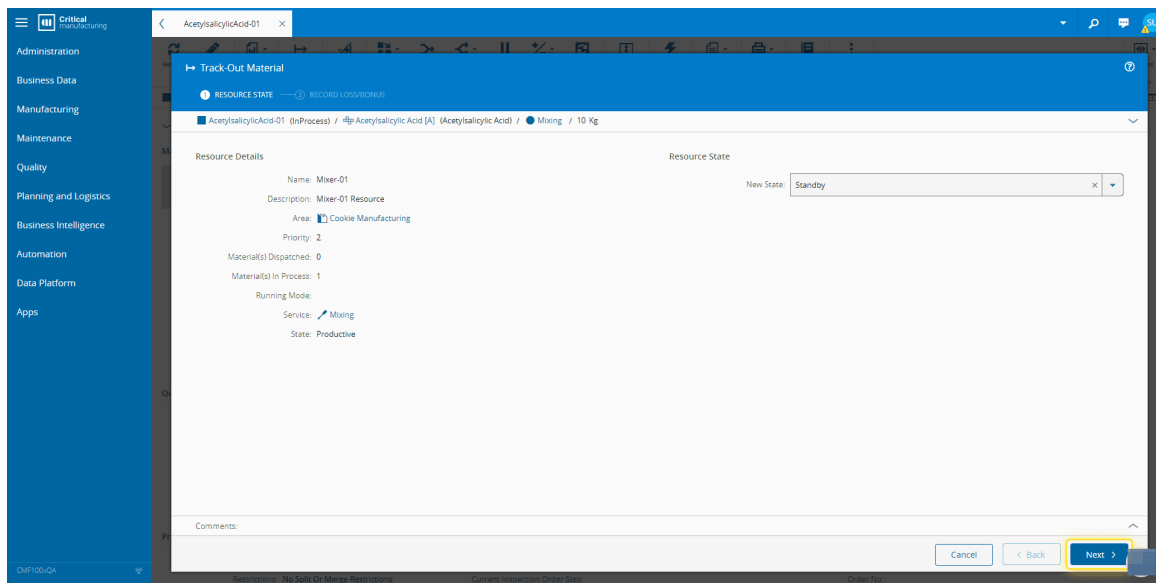


4. Select a the Track-Out button.

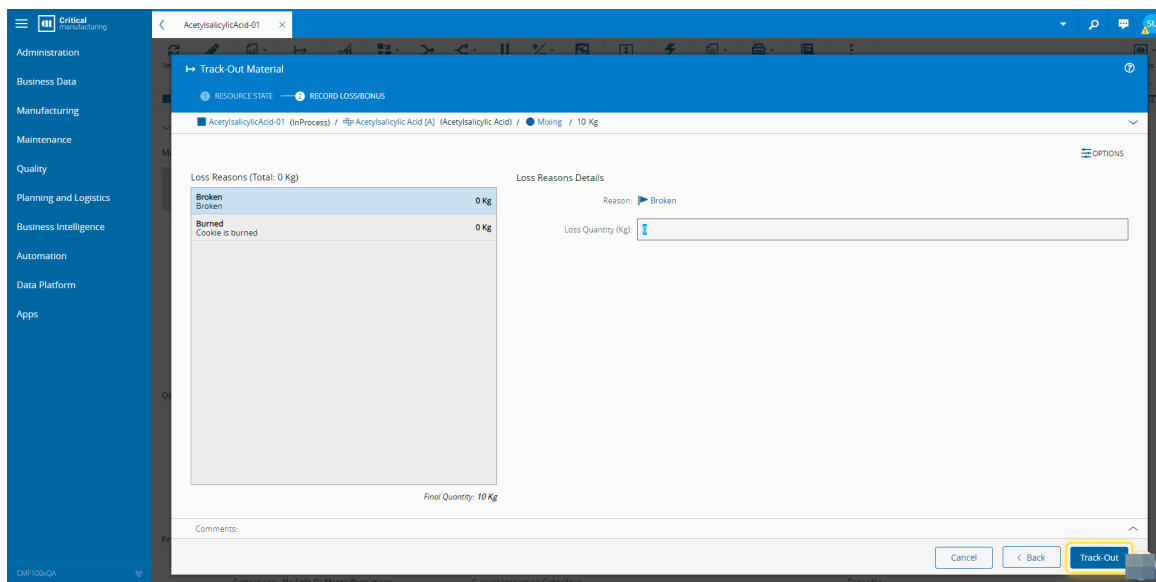
